#### 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of London Underground Oyster card

A limited edition Oyster card commemorating 150 years since the first Tube journey will be launched on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2012.

Where this Oyster card is also valid on another operator's services, the Conditions of Carriage of that operator will apply. Copies may be obtained from those operators.

Found cards should be returned to any Tube station ticket office.

#### Availability/validity

The card is the same as a standard retail adult Oyster card in terms of conditions of use, registration, deposit and adding pay as you go credit, Travelcards and Bus & Tram Passes.

#### Issuing Outlets

The cards will be available at London Underground ticket offices (including card issuing machines) and TfL Travel Information Centres. They will not be available from Oyster online, Oyster Ticket Stops, London Overground or National Rail stations.

A total of 1 million cards will be distributed as follows:

- An initial batch of 500,000 cards will be distributed to all London Underground stations and TfL Travel Information Centres over two weeks commencing 10<sup>th</sup> December 2012.
- The remaining 500,000 cards will be distributed in conjunction with scheduled deliveries.
