	claim for compensation from an adjoining landowner affected by a creation Order.
	We went to Defra for their view however it is a tricky issue for which they don't
	have a definitive answer.

Have any of you knowledge or experience of 'actionable at his suit' which might help with this issue? Could I have any responses by 14 August please.

Inspectors should refrain from making firm statements on compensation i.e. that adjacent landowners are not entitled to apply for compensation, unless they have expertise on the 'actionable at the suit of' issue.

2. A lot of Highway teams in local authorities are now undertaking rights of way work.

The RoW teams are monitoring the situation
