Thank you for your enquiry which we received on 7 September.

Following internal consultations, I can advise that unfortunately we have no record of which specific piece of legislation was used to affect this change in the geography of Ipswich.

I can only suggest that if it was not part of either the Dock Act of 1805 or the Dock Act of 1837, it may have been part of the legislation for the Gipping Canal in 1793. We do not hold copies of these acts from over 200 years ago.
