- CLOSURE OF 5 DAYS OR LESS Minimum 5 Weeks (County Roads) prior notice together with an administration fee of £600.00
- CLOSURES OF MORE THAN 5 DAYS Minimum of 7 Weeks prior notice together with an administration fee of £600.00. In addition, advertising costs will be charged at a later date; these will vary but will be about £700.00
- Preparation of alternative route sign schedule £200.00 (Optional)
- A further administration fee of £100.00 will be levied if circumstances require any measures
 to be introduced to control traffic on the chosen alternative route(s). Additional advertising
 costs may also be charged, as above.

- 2. The Applicant(s) shall be responsible for:
 - a) Posting the requisite Public Notice on site (This will be provided by the Highways Authority at the appropriate time) and ensuring that the Notices are removed immediately after the closure period. If notices are to be attached to lamp/sign posts, they are to be secured by a plastic cable tie or string. The applicant will be liable for any damage to the said lamp/sign post as a result of the attachment.
 - b) Advising all householders, landowners, businesses etc. along the length of road concerned about the works and closure.
 - c) Ensuring that pedestrian access is maintained at all times, together with, where practicable, vehicular access to adjacent properties.
 - d) Furnishing the Highway Authority with a plan indicating the proposed closure and diversionary route signs once an alternative route has been agreed.
 - e) Providing temporary signposting, including diversionary signs, in accordance with Chapter 8 of The Traffic Signs Manual, B.S. EN 12899-1:2007, BS 8442:2015 and The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. SIGNS SHALL BE BILINGUAL, WELSH TEXT UPPERMOST AND BE REFLECTORISED.
 - f) Indemnifying the County Council in respect of costs reasonably incurred by it or any alternative route of lower classification than the closed highway, to
 - i) improve or strengthen the highway or structure upon it to enable it to be used as an alternative route;
 - ii) make good any damage to the highway or structures upon it as a result of its use as an alternative route.
