The Islington (Prescribed Routes) (No. 27) Experimental Traffic Order 2020 Modification

Made: 23 December 2020  
Coming into force: 26 December 2020

---

1. The Council of the London Borough of Islington, in pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and pursuant to article 8 of The Islington (Prescribed Routes) (No. 27) Experimental Traffic Order 2020 and having consulted with the Commissioner of Police for the Metropolis, hereby modifies the provisions of that Order as specified in paragraph 2 below for the reason specified in paragraph 4 below.
2. The modifications to those provisions are that in article 6(b) the words “in an emergency” are hereby omitted.
3. The road affected by the Order is Queensland Road.
4. The reason for this modification is that it appears to the Council of the London Borough of Islington essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic and for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order mentioned above runs.
5. These modifications will take effect as from 26<sup>th</sup> December 2020.
