

# LONDON BOROUGH OF ISLINGTON TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

RELATING TO: ARSENAL EVENT DAYS (EAST AREA)

The Islington (Prescribed Routes) (No. 7) Experimental Traffic Order 2020

Made: 19 June 2020 Coming into force: 26 June 2020

The Council of the London Borough of Islington, after consulting with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:

## 1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Islington (Prescribed Routes) (No. 7) Experimental Traffic Order 2020 and shall come into force on 26 June 2020.

#### 2. Interpretation

In this Order:

any reference to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment;

"bus" has the same meaning as assigned to it in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (b);

"Emirates Stadium" means Arsenal Football Club Stadium situated between Drayton Park, Hornsey Road and Queensland Road, Islington;

"event" means a public sporting or entertainment event, held at the Emirates Stadium;

"event day" means a date listed in the Schedule to this Order, being either:

(i) a day on which an event is held, with an attendance of at least ten thousand spectators; or

(ii) a day on which an event is held, with an attendance of fewer than ten thousand spectators, and the Police Event Commander, or safety certificate holder if the police are not in attendance, direct that the implementation of the measures included in this order is necessary for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic;

"event finish time" means the expected or actual finish time of an event;

"event start time" means the expected or actual start time of an event;

"permission to access the Emirates Stadium" in relation to a vehicle or person means a vehicle, excluding a team bus, or a named individual that has been given permission by Arsenal Football Club to access the Emirates Stadium during an event;

"Police Event Commander" for the time being, means the senior police officer on duty at an event;

"restricted hours" means between 4 hours before the event start time and 1 hour after the event finish time;

"Safety certificate holder" means the authorised holder of the safety certificate relating to events or matches at the emirates stadium'

"Schedule" unless otherwise specified means any Schedule to this Order.

"team" means any sporting team, performer or associated personnel involved in an event;

"team bus" means any bus designated for a team.

- 3. The Police Event Commander or safety certificate holder if the police are not in attendance, shall be directly responsible for the implementation of all traffic management measures and the exact time within the restricted hours at which all traffic management measures, as prescribed by this Order, are implemented or suspended.
- 4. No person shall cause or permit the implementation of the traffic management measures, as prescribed by this Order, unless otherwise directed by the Police Event Commander, or safety certificate holder if the police are not in attendance.
- 5. Save as provided by Article 6 of this Order, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter or proceed in Queensland Road during the restricted hours.
- 6. Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall apply to:
  - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or the Police Event Commander, or safety certificate holder if the police are not in attendance:
  - (b) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
  - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

### 7. Modification or suspension of this Order

In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Service Director for the Council's Public Realm division for the time being, or some other person authorised in that behalf may, if it appears to them essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs, modify or suspend this Order or any provision thereof save that no modification shall make an addition.
