(HUNTINGDON AND GODMANCHESTER) CONTROL OF DOGS (VARIATION) ORDER 1976

The Cambridgeshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 31 of the Road Traffic Act 1972 (which said Act of 1972 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1972") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. The County of Cambridgeshire (Huntingdon and Godmanchester)
 Control of Dogs Order 1975 shall be varied by the deletion
 of all references in the Schedule to the said Order of the
 roads and lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to
 this Order and there shall be added to the Schedule to the
 said Order the roads and lengths of road specified in the
 Second Schedule to this Order.
 - 2. The Interpretation Act, 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
 - 3. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1976 and may be cited as "The County of Cambridgeshire (Huntingdon and Godmanchester) Control of Dogs (Variation) Order, 1976."
