## THE COUNTY OF CAMBRIDGESHIRE (WISBECH) CONTROL OF DOGS ORDER, 1975

The Cambridgeshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 31 of the Road Traffic Act 1972 (which said Act of 1972 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1972") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. For the purpose of sub-section (1) of Section 31 of the Act of 1972, the roads and lengths of roads in the Parish of Wisbech as specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be designated roads.
- 2. No person shall allow any dog or dogs belonging to him to be in those roads or lengths of road referred to in Article 1 at any time unless the said dog or dogs are kept on a lead.
- 3. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 4. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1975, and may be cited as "The County of Cambridgeshire (Wisbech) Control of Dogs Order 1975.


