## Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 - Request Ref 12597 Rotational Consultants to Caithness General Hospital

With reference to your request for information received on 24 January regarding the above, please find below your questions and our response:-

- 1. We would like to know the number of rotational medical consultants covering Caithness General hospital for 2021?
  - How many times for each week of 2021 that they attended Caithness General for face to face clinics?
  - How many times for each week of 2021 that they attended near me appointments for Caithness patients?

There are 7 Medical consultants that attend Caithness General on a rotational period. They cover Monday to Thursday each week and are committed to providing at least one Face to Face clinic during each visit while supporting all other activities. Near Me continues to be an option to support Caithness residents and will be used where clinically feasible.

- 2. We would also like to know the number of rotational surgical consultants covering Caithness General hospital for 2021?
  - How many times for each week of 2021 that they attended Caithness General Hospital for face to face clinics?
  - How many times for each week that they attended near me appointments for Caithness patients?

Under the surgical specialties, the consultants work for NHS Highland, and not to an individual unit. Surgical demand is met based on both the location of the patients and the availability of clinically appropriate and available space.

Within consultant job plans, there are elements to ensure service can be delivered in our Rural General Hospital sites, such as Caithness General Hospital in order to utilise all available spaces. It is also noteworthy that there have been recent appointments of 2 long term surgical consultants to be based at Caithness General Hospital to preserve surgical activity at the site.

With regards to Near Me, the situation is the same as medical where this will continue to be used where this is a clinically viable option.

• We would also like to know how many operations were carried out in Caithness General operating theatres for each week of 2021?
