Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

Please find below the University of Bradford's response to your request for information dated 4 February 2018

Your request:

- 1) Breakdown of expected salaries, or average salaries for graduates from undergraduate degrees in years 2008/2009 to 2013/2014 included, by subject. If average salaries for recent EU (non-UK) or international (non-EU) graduates are available, I would like those to be shared as well.
- 2) Tuition fees charged to first-year international students for undergraduate degrees in years 2008/2009 to 2013/2014 included, broken down by subject.

Our response

We are able to provide details on salaries for 2012 onwards. The Destination of Leavers of Higher Education survey which captures this information collected different information prior to 2012 and we reported differently and consequently do not hold this information prior to this date.

We are able to provide salary data per programme from 2012 onwards, however this is one figure for each programme, covering UK,EU and overseas students as well as full-time and part-time employment as we do not have separate data for each status of graduate.
