Dear Steve Kerr,

Thank you for your Freedom of Information request received on 2 July 2014. You asked:

"Please provide data for the number of adverse sanction decisions affecting individuals with dependent children in their household, in London for 2013/14. Please include all levels of sanctions for both JSA and ESA claimants."

We can confirm that the Department does hold some information falling within the description specified in your request. However, we estimate that the cost of complying with your request would exceed the appropriate limit of £600.

The appropriate limit has been specified in regulations and for central Government it is set at £600. This represents the estimated cost of one person spending 3½ working days in determining whether the Department holds the information, and locating, retrieving and extracting the information. Under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) the Department is not obliged to comply with your request and we will not be processing your request further.

Under section 16 of the FOIA we are obliged to assist you in providing options to narrow your request, by reforming or refocusing it, so that it will fall beneath the cost limit. In this case our advice would be to narrow your question so that it asks for information on the number of Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) or Employment and Support Allowance (ESA) claimant households with dependent children (at 31 May 2013), where the claimant has received an adverse sanction decision (by level of sanction for JSA) between 22 October 2012 and 31 May 2013 for JSA and 3 December 2012 and 31 May 2013 for ESA, for the London region.
