

I've been asked to describe certain secular benefits from Scientology auditing and training that are not generally understood to be religious or spiritual in nature, and how these have effected my community services activities.

I was first introduced to Scientology and the works of L. Ron Hubbard in 1970. I was impressed immediately by the practicality of the religion and its emphasis on self betterment based on a spiritual technology. I travelled abroad shortly after that but in the late 1970's started to study courses at the London centre and also to receive the spiritual counselling known as Auditing.

Prior to this I had been a drug user and had been in trouble with the law since my late teens. The first thing that happened when I became a Scientologist was my responsibility level went way higher than it had been before. I resolved to put things right and to be a contributing member of society. I joined a secular organisation called Narconon. The word means, literally, no drugs. Narconon rehabilitates drug users and alcoholics. It also has a drug education arm which visits schools and dissuades children from experimenting with drugs. Narconon's entire methodology is based on the researches of L. Ron Hubbard in this field.

Over the years I have worked extensively in schools throughout the UK. Years later I have bumped into students who attended these lectures, remembered me and thanked me, adding that as a result of my talk they had never been tempted to try drugs. The satisfaction and achievement from utilising L. Ron Hubbard's work to avoid the tragedy of narcotics is deep and fulfilling.

But that is not all. My interpersonal relationships, my ability to run a business, my ethical and spiritual awareness and my general desire to help other people have been improved immeasurably since becoming a Scientologist. When my mother finally passed away, after initially seeing her son become involved with drugs, gangs and crime, she told me in her final weeks how proud of me she had become and that the changes in me were marked and reassuring.

Dear Mr

I have been asked to write about any spiritual benefits I have received from Scientology and any benefits to others from my application of Scientology to them.

There are many occasions when I have been able to assist others through the benefits I have received from Scientology. One incident was while attending the death of my best friend who died of cancer in 1986. Maggie and I were very close, both British and divorcees living in Canada, we were like family to one another. At the time, I was quite new in Scientology and not doing very well trying to cope with the forthcoming tragedy. I was given some Scientology counselling/auditing to help me with the loss I was feeling and some knowledge about this subject death. Because of my greater understanding of the ultimate questions about life and death and myself as a spiritual being I was, during those days leading up to her death, a calming influence for Maggie and for her surviving three teenage children who were also very distraught over their mother's illness.

The knowledge and understanding I gained on the subject of life and death gave me a lot more strength to help the children overcome their grief.

Later, I had my next experience with death when my stepfather was dying - also of cancer. He was a lovely man whom I adored. While he lay dying in my mother's home, (he had released himself from the hospital in order to die at home) I administered daily Scientology spiritual assistance which, he told me, was the only thing that gave him relief from the pain. My mother needed assistance also, since she was sick and not doing well under the strain. I was able to pull her through by using some of the Scientology auditing or counselling procedures which commonly assist people during a time of loss.

Just before my stepfather passed away, he told me that he was afraid to die because he did not want to leave my mother. He was concerned there would be no-one to look after her. He was distressed, very frail and in terrible pain but trying very hard to hang on to life. Using some of the Scientology principles relating to communication when attending a person close to death, I was able to calm him down and reassure him everything would be all right. He died peacefully and calmly 8 hours later.

I regularly use Scientology procedures to give relief to the sick, to babies that are upset or crying out of control, to drunken people to sober them up. Just recently I was visiting a non-Scientology friend who was confined to her bed by her doctor due to a bad bout of shingles. I applied a Scientology procedure which helps to soothe the body nerves and while giving assistance she felt the pain disappear and was back on her feet within the next few days. Her doctor had told her she would be bedridden for several days and was only allowed on her feet for very short periods. This lady now does the same procedure on her boyfriend to calm his nerves since he is a bit hyperactive. She has expressed the joy in the changes she sees in him.

One Christmas, while staying with a girlfriend and her family in Winnipeg, I gave a similar assistance to sober up a very drunken young man who kept insisting he was going to drive his snow mobile home. The atmosphere in the party started to change as guests tried to talk him out of it. As he kept insisting, I followed him outside and started giving him some Scientology assistance which sobers up a drunk man. Within, 5 minutes he suddenly opened his eyes wide, stood straight up and looked at me straight in the eye and asked me, what I had done. He was no longer slurring his words but speaking coherently. He felt completely sober. He walked back into the house and handed the keys to his brother and told him they were going to walk home. The people were completely amazed and could not figure out what had happened. Just before leaving, he turned to me and said, "I don't know what you did, or what you call that thing back there, but thank you - you just saved my life."

My responsibility for charitable actions has increased through Scientology. I was responsible for organising a very large Santa's Grotto for the Children of East Grinstead to raise toys for the Salvation Army and Barnardos Homes. I converted a large warehouse at the back of a store into a 1500 square foot display. I got local Scientology and non-Scientology traders and businesses to donate most of the materials needed to create an evergreen forest with reindeers and Disney characters. Santa's log cabin was beautiful. A free photograph with Santa was promoted if children would bring along one of their old toys for a child. We had a large Santa's sleigh which was filled three times over with toys. Over 1000 children came and received their photo along with a Mars or Snicker Bar donated from the Mars Company. It was a great success and hundreds of beautiful toys were donated to the two charities.

I've worked on the Say No To Drugs campaigns, Clean Up Your Environment campaigns for local councils and the Christmas Lights campaigns for our local town. I have helped organise large charity concerts with Isaac Hayes and Jermaine Jackson where proceeds went to a youth anti drug charity and Lifeboat charity. I have organised charity fetes at Saint Hill to support local such charities as St John's Ambulance. I have also worked in the field of Human Rights for many years. I have assisted sexually abused men, women and children bring justice to over 100 psychiatrists and psychologists. I recently assisted my husband in putting together an Ad Hoc Committee with members of the House of Lords and well known academics to investigate discrimination against religious and ethnic minorities in Germany.

I am on the Advisory Board of the Human Detoxification Services International, a non-profit body which has trained over 200 Russian scientists and doctors on Mr Hubbard's detoxification process. Many people, including children of the Chernobyl disaster have been given a new and extended life free of radiation and pollution poisoning. This detoxification has been applied to hundreds of people suffering from the effects of drug and environmental pollution.

From my position on the Advisory board, I am at present assisting in organising an International Conference in Stockholm where over 100 delegates from the US, Russia and Europe are scheduled to release their latest research papers on the success of Mr Hubbard's detoxification process in their respective countries. This also includes the successes achieved by the Gulf War victims. The detoxification process is working to eliminate the poisons and toxins from their bodies also.

The most dramatic thing I have ever done as a Scientologist was to bring relief to a person who was having a psychotic reaction from the anti-depressant drug, Prozac and who was threatening to shoot himself, his wife and two children. I was working for the Citizen's Commission on Human Rights (CCHR). I received a phone call from a woman, who had been taken by the police, with her children, to a battered wives home. She said her husband had gone crazy, smashed up the house and was threatening to shoot her and the two children if she stepped back into the house. The police refused to intervene any further since they were not allowed by American law to get involved with domestic problems. The wife was terrified. Her husband was on Prozac and she said he had a loaded shotgun. She had recently watched a television programme in which CCHR discussed the violent and suicidal reactions the drug was having on hundreds of people across America and she called CCHR. She begged me to call her husband and find out if he was okay and to help him.

When I phoned the home, the husband answered the phone yelling at me as if I was his wife. He was out of control and was very psychotic and evil. He was threatening to kill his wife and the children. He said he had the gun loaded and was waiting for her to walk through the door and he would blow her and the kids heads off. A colleague called the police but the police were unable to do any more since he was "entitled to do what he wanted in his own home."

For the next two hours, and using only the communication techniques I had learnt on the basic Scientology Communication Course, I kept him talking until a Prozac survivor from the Prozac Survivor's Support Group arrived to be with him and take care of him. During the time I was on the phone, he would switch between a Jeckyl and Hyde personality, one minute crying on the phone that he loved his wife and children, that he had been happily married for 15 years and didn't know why he was holding a loaded gun or why his house was trashed.

The next minute, as quick as turning a light bulb on he would be back into yelling profanities down the phone and threatening to kill himself and his family. Using the drills I had learnt from the Scientology course, I kept pulling him out of it, getting him back onto talking about pleasure moments he had with his wife and children.

For the next six weeks, and with co-operation from his family doctor, somebody stayed with him constantly in his own home to make sure he did not commit suicide. After he was fully recovered and off the Prozac, CCHR received a beautiful letter expressing his sincere thanks for saving his life and those of his family.

Being a Scientologist for over 12 years, I have many stories and could go on for many pages and would be willing to write more. My life has now become devoted to not only improving the quality of my own life but more importantly to improve the quality of other peoples around me.

One final thing. I am so pleased I was asked to write this letter as looking back over some of the things I have done and achieved as a Scientologist gave me a sense of great pride and achievement which I have not looked at for a long time. Being a Scientologist is an often hectic and busy life and I think we forget to take stock at some of the really wonderful things we do in our normal everyday lives. Before Scientology, I felt I was destined to a life with no meaning, no purpose and lots of loneliness and unhappiness. It was an unfulfilling life consisting mainly of tedious work, television, occasional visits to the theatre, local bars and night clubs for entertainment and most of all the hollow relationships. With Scientology however, I have come alive and all my dreams have not only come true but I have surpassed them. I'm very proud that I'm a Scientologist but more importantly, I can do what I have always wanted to do and that is, to help others improve their lives.

I write to you as I have been asked to describe the secular benefits I have received from Scientology auditing and training and how these have resulted in community betterment overall.

I have been involved with Scientology since 1975 and have had great results from both the auditing and training that I have done in Scientology. Before I started with Scientology I was very unsure, often depressed and had no direction in my life. Also my responsibility towards society at large was very low. Since starting with Scientology this has changed gradually for the better and I now do much better myself and also my family is doing very well.

With regard to taking more responsibility and changing conditions in the society at large, I have also in that area experienced the results of the training and auditing. This training and auditing has made me more aware of the ills of society and man and gave me the ability and hope that something actually can be done about these ills, such as in the areas of crime, drug addiction, education and morals. In Holland, where I lived until 1990, I have helped in founding a school based on the educational principles developed by L. Ron Hubbard. As you may know these principles are widely used in society and have a direct effect on the ability of children to study better and thus become more able members of society, and indirectly these principles have a positive effect on behavioural and disciplinary problems, thus creating less crime, less drug dependency and in general help create a better world.

In the UK I have started up and am currently the National Director of Criminon UK, a criminal rehabilitation organisation which is running 'Self-Improvement' extension courses for prisoners. Criminon UK is at this moment solely run by volunteers (all Scientologists) we are about 25 at the moment, who all do this work next to their normal job. We currently have about 75 prisoners on the Criminon programme of which the main part is the *Way to Happiness* course, which teaches common sense values and get prisoners to actually apply the moral precepts taught on the course. The results of this course are sometimes phenomenal, with criminals getting fully rehabilitated and regaining their self-respect.

One of the prisoners who did this course wrote:

"Truth is truth and facts are facts. And after 50 years of life with 30 of it behind bars in all its prison misery and hatreds, I found myself shrunken and nothing of worth existing in a self-justifying world of predatory belligerence and immorality. Surrounded with violence and every imaginable betrayal a common occurrence. With barely a memory of anything near Happiness, Joy or Pleasure, I was buried alive and steeped in sorrow. By pure chance I found one day a Way to Happiness booklet and came in contact with for the first time an understanding and knowledge of The Golden Rule with its common sense

practice of the virtues. I now feel hope returning to myself daily through the use of the virtues. Little by little with courage and will I am regaining a foothold with purpose and strength on the highway to Happiness path. With time and practice I will become stronger and survive, flourish and prosper as a decent individual, conscious of a better me, hopeful of happiness."

Other courses run by Criminon deal with literacy, handling suppression, handling drugs, communication tools, how to live with children, personal integrity and other 'Life Improvement' courses. This programme leads up to the fact that the prisoner starts to see that he can live a crime free life and gives him the basic tools to do so.

Criminon is part of Narconon, a registered charity, of which I am a trustee. As a trustee I take an active part in expanding the effectiveness of the drug education and rehabilitation to achieve a drug free society.

Both through my work with Criminon and Narconon I try to help create a better society for our kids to grow up in. It is very unlikely that I would have taken up these activities if hadn't received Scientology auditing and taken Scientology training, which I directly attribute to me taking more responsibility and actually being able to do something about society's ills.

Dear Sir,

I have been asked to describe the benefits I have received from Scientology auditing and training and how these have resulted in community betterment overall.

I took my first Scientology service over 28 years ago and have been an active Scientologist ever since. But when I first contacted Scientology, I was not doing very well in life at all. I had given up work altogether and was leading a purposeless life with no intention of becoming re-employed. I was drinking heavily on a daily basis and could see no real hope for my future. However, within just a few weeks of finding Scientology and doing two of the basic courses, my life had already begun to change for the better. I stopped my heavy drinking totally and to this day rarely have more than one or two drinks at Christmas for social reasons. But even more important for me, Scientology gave me a valuable purpose in life and that is to do what I can to help my friends, relatives and even people I don't know to lead happier and more fulfilling lives. To offer my help whenever they may be in trouble.

After my first few training courses I was confident enough to apply what I had learned to help strangers I came across who were in trouble. One youngman I found outside a pub, sitting in the snow very drunk and not in good shape at all. Using what I had learned I was able to bring this man out of his drunken state and back into a normal condition in only about 5 minutes. He was able to stand, walk normally and hold a normal conversation in just these few minutes. And not long after this time I found an elderly lady who had slipped on the pavement and fallen unconscious. In just a few minutes I was able to bring her round to where she was smiling and talking again. I stayed with her until the emergency services arrived.

Currently in my life I carry out voluntary work at my local hospital, The Queen Victoria Hospital in East Grinstead. I have worked for more than 8 years as part of the hospital radio team. During this time I have spent hundreds of hours visiting patients in the wards, cheering them up particularly when they don't have anyone visiting them and offering them the opportunity to have a record of their choice played on the hospital radio. I have also spent many hours working on the radio itself as a presenter

and have helped to raise money through our hospital radio charity events which has gone towards, amongst other things, new hospital equipment to help improve the service of our hospital. Just recently I raised over £ 150 sponsorship for a young girl who had had an operation at our hospital and wanted to repay the nurses by doing a sponsored skip. (Please see attached article from our local newspaper showing the girl, a nurse from the childrens ward and myself.)

Some years ago, I attended two separate first aid courses at the East Grinstead Red Cross so that I could better help people in trouble should I encounter them. On two separate occasions after completing these courses I was first on the scene of two car accidents both in East Grinstead. In each case I took charge of the situation using both what I had learnt from my Scientology courses and from my first aid courses to check the victims over and make them comfortable until the ambulances arrived. I was able to ensure that each of the victims was not moved unnecessarily as I knew the risk of moving someone who may have broken their back during an accident and so felt that I helped considerably in the lives of these two people.

About 8 years ago, a friend of mine brought his girlfriend to me as she had been on drugs for many years and was totally addicted to them. She was in a very bad way and close to being suicidal. So I contacted Narconon, the drug rehabilitation charity who gave me some very helpful advice on how to help her. Over the next 2 1/2 months both myself and another Scientologist visited her on alternate days to help her through the withdrawal symptoms. Finally she was able to give up all the drugs she was taking and to this day has never reverted back to taking drugs and leads a much happier life because of this.

Just last year when my mother died, my brother was very upset and distressed over the situation. I felt a great deal of sympathy for him and did whatever I could to comfort him and to take charge of things so that he could work his way through the loss in his own time and with as little stress as possible. I felt that my understanding of people which I have gained from my Scientology courses helped me tremendously to assist my brother during this time.

Since taking up Scientology I have assisted thousands of injured or distressed people by using what I have learnt in my studies and continue to help anyone I come across who might need it. Earlier this year, I helped to organise over 60 Scientologists to attend the London Marathon race where we assisted over 650 runners when they came through the finishing line in many cases completely exhausted and sometimes unable to walk. As I have attended several marathon runs over the past few years it was not unusual for some of the runners to search out the Scientologists including myself for assistance after the run.

My life has changed so much for the better since I first found Scientology and I continue to enjoy life and really like to see others doing well in life. I hope this helps to give some insight into how Scientology can help people. It has certainly helped me.



I Have been asked to describe some of the benefits I have received from taking Scientology auditing and training.

I have known of Scientology since the very early 1950's, when my older sisters became interested and familiar with L Ron Hubbard's work. My first benefit from the technology was in 1958, when I received a 20 minute auditing session, and a rash, which I had had over my entire body, totally disappeared.

This made me aware that Scientology could help people.

In 1969, my marriage collapsed and my doctor gave me very heavy tranquillisers to calm me. After taking the tablets for 10 days, I realised that far from helping me, they were actually harmful, and as I had two small daughters to look after on my own, I needed to get some constructive help.

I arranged to go to St Hill Manor, Sussex, and receive some counselling, for which my parents paid. As soon as I arrived at St Hill, I was told not to have any more tranquillisers and while I was waiting for 10 days for the effects of the pills to wear off, I completed a small course and read some simple books on Scientology.

I was then given counselling, which was so beneficial, that I could have repaired my marriage, had my husband been willing to do so. I continued to bring up my children, then aged 9 and 11, totally single-handedly, without any financial support to speak of from my husband. I put both of my daughters through college and they have now been married, very happily, for 17 and 15 years, with children of their own. I see them all 2- 3 times a week. My oldest daughter has not shown any interest in becoming a scientologist, but she and her family support me in everything I do.

During the following years, I trained as much as possible in Scientology, and became a trained counsellor so that I could help others as I had been helped.

Over the past 16 years, I have helped organise a small charity group in Brixton, specialising in supplementary teaching to the ethnic minorities, using Mr Hubbard's educational technology. We have also taught older students how to communicate with others- after which a high percentage found work for the first time in their lives - often having spent their formative years inside juvenile detention centres. This has been a particularly satisfying experience. In the last month I was sent a letter from a man in prison, who having been given a Way to Happiness booklet, by his mother in Brixton, has asked to be sent more booklets to pass to other prisoners, as he feels that that could well benefit from the down to earth premises in the book.

I have a full time job at a large factory in East Grinstead, where I am the Accounts Manager and Company Secretary. I am also a part time guide at an historic castle a few miles away - I have been employed in these jobs for well over 10 years. In my spare time, I am a very active member of local theatre groups, playing leading roles in plays and musicals. In all my activities I am well known as a scientologist and I am always asked for my help, when problems arise.

In my own large family, I am regularly phoned up by relations who ask my advice to solve a family problem, and in the street where I live, my neighbours also come to me to help them with many different problems.

Using Scientology technology, I have helped my family, friends and the people with whom I come in contact, and many times I have had people tell me how much happier they have been after talking to me. One recent example was a seven year old child who was in a musical play with me. She had stage fright just before the curtain went up. I took her onto the stage and did a simple scientology drill with her for about 2 minutes. Her nervousness went, and she performed beautifully. Afterwards, I received a little present from her, thanking me for having got rid of her stage fright.

As I was going along on training courses in Scientology I also managed to repair a huge familial rift that had occurred as a result of me using drugs. L. Ron Hubbard's data on communication was incredibly easy to use and was so effective. You must understand that my parents and I had barely spoken for some four years and as you can imagine I was a huge disappointment to them. We have a very good relationship today, full of love for each other and mutual respect (which by the way if you earn that from my father is something). We no longer argue and have been the best of friends for a long time now. I fully believe that this would never have happened without Scientology's help and am grateful for it. These are just two of the things I have handled in my life as a result of Scientology.

The biggest result of all the training I have is that I am now working as a volunteer in the field of criminal rehabilitation in my evening and weekends with a charity called Criminon. I help inmates cope with prison life, increase their self-respect, dignity and happiness. This helps to change their attitude and outlook on life for the better. Most of them have no hope as to their own personal reform but using the things I have learnt in my training I have noticed changes occur with inmates that is very encouraging. Using the information L Ron Hubbard provides for criminals it makes a great difference to the quality of all the lives of the inmates concerned as the ones I am working with are daily applying things that increase their morals. That naturally has knock on effect on the others there. For instance one inmate was working on helping others to take care of themselves and he decided that he was going to help an inmate that was not eating properly. He daily went to the inmates cell and got the inmate to accompany him to the hotplate so that they might eat together. The other inmate now comes to his cell to go and eat and he no longer neglects himself. This is just one

example of change that can be made by someone who ordinarily would not care for the welfare for others.

I have to admit that previously to any Scientology training I would not have had the confidence to take responsibility for others, I really thought it was someone else's job and " nothing to do with me " . I realised that had I not done any Scientology at all I would never be in a position to better myself or that of the lives of others.

I hope this letter helps to validate the help that Scientology can be to the community as it is my belief that if there were more people similar to myself who were able to benefit others then we could all greatly improve the lives of those in our communities to a larger extent and it wouldn't fall on the shoulders of just a few.

I have been asked to describe certain 'secular' benefits I have received from Scientology auditing and training that are not generally understood to be religious or spiritual in nature and how these have affected my community services activities.

My name is _____ and I am a volunteer minister for the Church of Scientology.

I have enclosed testimonials from some people who are not Scientologists. I have been able to help these people because of my knowledge of the works of L Ron Hubbard, using skills I had no knowledge of what-so-ever prior to becoming a Scientologist nearly four years ago. I have also enclosed a card which is from one of at least 20 people I have stopped and helped at roadside incidents ranging from people simply being lost to accidents where there was much confusion and hostility when I arrived and calm and order when I left having specifically dealt with the emotion of the scene.

I will explain the card I have enclosed in brief.

The sight of a white peugeot stopped at the side of the A3 on the London bound carriage way with a young woman in it caused me to stop and see if I could help.

The young woman in her early twenties was extremely distressed - she had not broken down, she had had a panic attack and felt completely unable to drive the rest of her journey to Richmond (approximately 15 miles away.)

I asked her what had happened. She explained her emotions at that time. I asked if this had happened before she said that it had. Having told me about another occasion and insisting that nothing like that had ever happened before and having established that she had just come back from a trip to India and having acknowledged her emphatic statement that nothing like this had ever happened before, I asked her if there was an earlier similar incident she replied that there was not but then went on to tell me in great detail about a seemingly unrelated incident which had happened a few weeks previously in India. At the end of her account she was much brighter and she asked me who I was and where had

I learned that stuff and what was it I had been doing anyway. She had considered going to see a counsellor and told me what a waste of time that would have been compared to what I had just done.

I had observed that Sue, the girl in question, was a bit underweight. I explained the importance of nutrition in direct relation to mental health and was able to give some simple basic advice. All of the help that I was as referred to in this letter and enclosures was totally unknown to me before I knew about Scientology.

I came into Scientology because a friend of mine had his life saved when Narconon cured him of a fourteen year addiction to Methadone.

He went from being a registered addict who was on benefits with a habit which was costing 1,000 pounds per month to taking back control of his own life. He went to Narconon 5 years ago and has never looked back since. He has a good job and now contributes to his family and society. His family no longer subsidises his habit (they did not know they were subsidising his drugs). He will never go back to taking hand-outs and the value of his contribution to society simply by becoming a tax payer effects us all.

The selfless determinism of the people I met who worked at Narconon and the changes I saw in my friend, (the closest thing I will ever see to a miracle perhaps), inspired me to find out more about the works of L Ron Hubbard.

I have helped to raise hundreds of pounds for Narconon, organising street collections and in other ways, if someone that I am talking to complains of a pain which is causing them discomfort I am able to act there and then to help relieve that pain because of what I can do thanks to L Ron Hubbards discoveries in this area.

I have assisted fatigued and exhausted runners alongside many other Scientologists at several marathons not least of which the London Marathon. People who have been assisted routinely express amazement at the simple effectiveness of the technique. One person said they thought they were going to be in bed for a week after the Marathon and now thought they would be all right the next day. I have assisted hundreds of people and I know I have been of real value to those people because they always say so.

Using what I know of L Ron Hubbard's techniques I have helped many children to know how they can improve there studies and so do better in life. When I was teaching a drama group a couple of years ago I discovered I had one boy in the group who always seemed to cause trouble. Having established that he was failing to learn at school and by his account, did not have any friends and was often in fights at school, I suggested that he should come to my house once a week and I would show him how he could help himself to learn well and do better in society. He was eleven and following two terms of coming to my house for just one hour a week after school he was no longer in the dyslexia unit at school and getting commended in all his subjects. I nearly cried the day he came to my house and told me his finest news, he had a best friend.

The achievement I am proudest of and the happiest change in my life is a new relationship with one of my brothers and one of my sisters (I have one other brother and

two sisters). The brother and sister I am referring to have both been under a psychiatric regime for nearly all their lives. Since becoming a Scientologist and using listening skills which were completely unknown to me previously I have learned so much about my siblings and we have become very close where we never had been before. I can perhaps best express this by saying I have now lost count of the times we have found ourselves in tearful happy hugs when they have originated something that they had never told anyone before and had always felt it would never be OK to do so. We were strangers living in the same house when we were growing up and it was not because there was six years between me and my sister and ten years between me and my brother. I am sad to say I did not want to know them. I know now I did not know how to know them.

I am proud of my brother and my sister and love all my family very dearly. My brother said recently that I was the best friend he had ever had and the first person to have ever really listened to him. I leave you to imagine how that made me feel. He knows only that things are very different between us now. I know that Scientology is why.

To draw a difference between now and the time before I knew about Scientology, in a nutshell I was on benefits and didn't even have any sense that I was part of a community and now I could fill a book with the stories of the improvements I have been able to make in my own life and the lives of those around me as a direct result of the teachings of L Ron Hubbard.

If he was around now I would give him such a big hug if I met him. He is such a reliable friend. I hope you think so too.

It has been requested of me to describe some of the benefits that I and others have obtained as a result of my connection with The Church of Scientology for the past 27 years.

The benefits have been too numerous to count over the years; probably the most significant, however, was an incident which would completely change my life.

I was involved in a road traffic accident ^{at the age of 20} & I was the driver of the car and totally responsible.

for hitting a brick wall and putting my hands out through the windshield. She passed her forehead which would scar her for life. I was relatively content for life. I was suspicious for obvious reasons. However, each night I went to bed I couldn't sleep with the pain in my back.

My father, a dentist offered me advice to my injury. I refused saying I didn't want any of that medical stuff, I was a state registered nurse & could handle pain.

The pain persisted and after a number of sleepless nights I became desperate. I accepted my dad's offer of help. Nothing short of a miracle occurred.

Within ten short minutes the pain had gone following a realization that I was having the pain there because I felt guilty about causing my

Sister's bodily harm and that I should suffer along with her!

This opened up new vistas for me. My profession as a nurse would have dealt with such an injury by the use of pain killers or similar drugs. All drugs do is camouflage what's actually going on; whereas with the assistance of a Dieteticist the root cause is found and handled terminally.

This realisation made it difficult to continue nursing, handling patients by the use of drugs knowing more effective and permanent solutions are available. Please note: this is not to say that some medical treatments & drugs are absolutely necessary to survival at certain times.

However, this also led to a more serious issue - the barbarism of ECT (electro-convulsive therapy) leucotomies, lobotomies etc.

Once I had taken on honest work at the situation I had no choice but to resign my nursing position.

I then trained myself as a Diabetic as that I could help others. I have helped literally hundreds of people by providing assistance that relieves of injured or distressed people. I have even helped individuals on a flight with a fear of flying and one lady who couldn't even board the plane. Other such incidents are helping individuals to have babies without the use of drugs, handling horse riding accidents, unconscious persons requiring consciousness, burns, exhaustion (from work or running a marathon) etc. etc.

The feeling one gets for being able to assist others in this way is most rewarding.

During recent years I have helped in the charity, Narcoson

This group delivers very effective drug education lectures into schools. These lectures are delivered by an ex-addict. I have read literally hundreds of surveys which these students compete following the lecture. These state that they now know the truth, about drugs and that they will not do drugs themselves and will discourage others. These lectures give the students the facts and these students like to be telling that it is not an "Author" telling them, such as a Teacher or a politician.

I also helped several addicts to 'kick the habit' through the Narcotics Rehabilitation programme. I was

one client severely 'jaundiced' on alcohol, severely 'jaundiced' a very week. His 'diet' was one of peeling these small dried tomatoes & gristly cornmeal. Within 2 days of the

Norron programme the 'pauze' was hardly detectable. When on week he was sitting down to a meal of steak & vegetables! by birth, but who arrived from Belgium to do the Norron programme - also an Alsatian. The problem was totally resolved within 12 weeks.

I have met both these people some time after completing the Norron programme & both are doing well in life with the alcohol problem resolved. These 'miracles' occur regularly across the planet through the application of L-Ron Hubbard's technology - be it secular or religious nature.

In my view everything possible should be done to dispend such an organisation and bring about a less turbulent world.

I have been asked to describe certain 'secular' benefits I have received from Scientology auditing and training that are not generally understood to be religious or spiritual in nature and how these have affected my community services activities. I myself have received great benefits from Scientology since I started Scientology in 1974. I was teaching in leadership and having a very difficult time, as I had just experienced a broken marriage and the loss of my child in a custody battle. I was a tranquilliser and life for me was very hard. Scientology enabled me to come off the tranquillisers and helped me to get on with my ex-husband so that we could discuss my child securely. It liberated my life and gave me codes of integrity to live by. Once I was on my own two feet I was able to help my fellow. This I do on a daily basis as a volunteer Minister - not a paid post as staff in a Scientology organization. I head a group of about 40 people who help

others in the community.

We currently are helping a man with multiple sclerosis. We visit him on a rota and supply his needs and give him comfort. We found accommodation for a man who could not cope with life any more, helped him with shopping, washing, looking after himself and helping him to cook for himself. He has improved under this care and can now manage for himself with our help.

He comes to my house once a week for dinner and I liaise with his daughter in Australia about him and she is extremely grateful to us for this. (see letter enclosed).

There is a 93 year old lady who is our neighbour. Her family live in Sheffield and she has no-one here who have almost 'adopted' her and she comes to our house and friends for Christmas, birthdays and occasions and comes to my house once a week for dinner. She has blossomed since being in our care.

There was a 13 year old girl who was being bullied at school. Her mother was distant about it as the girl refused to go to school. She became very withdrawn and wouldn't speak to ~~her~~ her parents about her problems. I was able to talk with her and help her with

with her study, which she did at home. This was unpaid. Gradually she gained in confidence and with her mother's determination and ours that she could get better we got her into Greenfield's Short Store she has done very well and even got stellar results in 'A' levels at the young age of 16. She is also now doing giving musical concerts in public and is able to mix with others. I was then also able to help her mother when she was ill.

I helped two different ladies face death. They both had cancer terminally. I was able to get them to face it and give them comfort and the ability to talk about it. (see enclosed letter ④) I received after one lady died.)

It is difficult to write about all I/we do as we are doing it all the time. We have helped literally hundreds of people. It is good too to have a group as we can organise help for people and share it out between us. We also help people by assisting them after they have run marathons I deliberately look out for people who need a hand, wherever I am. I also try to make people feel

brighter and happier in daily life
just by smiling and going outside to
chat to them. Usually they tell
me all sorts about their lives and
feel better for it.
Receiving Scientology services has
enabled me to look beyond myself
has given me the understanding of
how people 'tick' and ways to
help them.
