## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002 SUBJECT: ARRESTS AT CUP FINAL

I refer to your email dated 7<sup>th</sup> April regarding the above which has been handled in accordance with the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA).

## QUESTION

Can you please advise how many arrests have been made and attributed to the Scottish Challenge Football Cup, currently the Ramsdens Cup final, each year for the last ten years?

## **RESPONSE**

Events such as this football fixture result in an incident being created on the 'command and control' system, with a summary being added to the incident at the closure of the event. The following information has been recorded within this summary in relation to the number of arrests made in the years in question:

06/07: McDairmid Park – 1 arrest in the stadium (4,062 in attendance)

07/08: Dens Park, Dundee – No arrests in the stadium, two arrests outside the stadium (5,446 in attendance)

08/09: McDairmid Park – No arrests (4,032 in attendance)

09/10: McDairmid Park – 1 arrest in the stadium (8,031 in attendance)

10/11: McDairmid Park – No arrests (4,078 in attendance)

11/12: Almondvale, Livingston – 1 arrest in the stadium (5,210 in attendance)

12/13: Almondvale – 1 arrest in the stadium (9,452 in attendance)

13/14: Easter Road, Edinburgh – 9 arrests in the stadium. Please note that a further 11 arrests occurred pre-match following a disturbance in the Grassmarket, and another three arrests occurred in the area surrounding the stadium during the dispersal process. (19,983 in attendance).

Please note that the information for the 04/05 and 05/06 season is no longer held, and Section 17 of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 is therefore applied.
