Many thanks for your email and our subsequent phone call regarding Security at the PNR site.

I'm pleased to confirm that our Guards stood down at 7pm last night, as agreed, confirming that the site had been left secure and clean.

We briefly discussed on the phone that in the event you need us to assist with security again, we can normally have guards in place within 24 hours of instruction, in practice we could have Guards in place within 12 hours. Hopefully with your new order you won't need us as I'm sure Cuadrilla security will be able to manage the site.

For info, I notice that a shale gas firm obtained a High Court order regarding protesters behavior, thinking it might be useful for LCC or Flyde Police to explore this angle of the law. Thank you for your email.

As you can appreciate the verge areas at the Cuadrilla site are very contentious areas and senior officers here have had briefings with Cabinet members etc as to the way forward and looking at the highway powers we have .

I am instructed to let you know that we will not be intending to continue contracting with you for security on the verge areas after next week and would even ask if Phoenix HCE would be willing to cease the security contract even before that end date.

The Temporary Traffic Regulation Order made today enables Cuadrilla and their security to enter the highway areas. The Order is made because of their works on or near the highway. It is hoped that this will prevent the highway verge areas from being occupied by tents and towers again.

We have hugely appreciated your help in this matter and realise that there is still the footage of the enforcement to come over. It may also be that further enforcement will be required at or near this location given the protester activity and and I hope that you might be happy to again quote for and take instructions from us re any further action in the future.

Please let me know if you are content to change the agreement and end the contract for security early or whether it will continue until the 9th.
