The following statement has been provided outside of the Freedom of Information Act.

“We are working with Transport for London to actively encourage anyone who experiences any sexual behaviour that makes them feel uncomfortable to come forward and report it, with the confidence that it will be taken seriously and it will be investigated. Every single report matters. It helps us build a picture so the offender can be tracked down, caught and brought to justice.

Sexual offences are complex enquiries, however we police a CCTV rich environment and use this evidence to identify offenders and collect intelligence. We also have a dedicated team of officers who patrol the underground, looking to identify known offenders as well as prevent further offences.
