Six (6) suppliers (including Bangor University) were invited to tender for contract FC-73-02-337; however, Bangor University did not submit a tender.

Five (5) suppliers were invited to tender for contract 105 EPG 08; York University was the only bidder for the contract and therefore it was awarded to them.
