Freedom of information review request

Thank you for your email of 10 October 2018 requesting a review of the University's handling of your request about MBChB (UCAS code A100) application statistics on the basis that we misunderstood one part of your request.

Part 5 of your original request of 14 September 2018 asked for the numbers of applicants applying with maximum points (34) for academic grades, the UKCAT, and the Situational Judgement Test (SJT) in years of entry 2016, 2017, and 2018. My colleague Brian Cherry wrote to you on 10 October 2018 providing separate figures for applicants applying with maximum points for academic grades, the UKCAT, and the SJT.

You explained that you wanted the number of applicants with full UKCAT, academic grades, and SJT points in combination, so those applying with 34 points out of 40 before the personal scoring section was assessed. I apologise for this misunderstanding. The numbers of applicants who achieved a score of 34 prior to personal scoring are given in Table 1, below

Table 1: Applicants achieving a combined score of 34 for UKCAT, academic grades and SJT points, 2016/17-2018/19.
