The council holds the information requested and the answers to your questions are as follows:

1. *Does the council have a framework for SEN Transport or Home to School transport?*

Yes for taxi travel but the bus service is operated in-house

2. *Are taxi suppliers able to join now? If not when does the current framework expire?*

Taxi suppliers cannot join now – the current framework expires in Sept 2023

3. *Which month will taxi suppliers be able to apply to join the framework/ a new tender be posted?*

Taxi suppliers cannot join now – the current framework expires in Sept 2023
