- Conversions – 177 to go
- EHC new - 20-27% very low and must improve - timeliness of reports, use of Enhance
- Process of EHC assessment - all about me/key outcomes and provision planning
- Timeliness of reports key issue – 20% on time
- Single Route of Redress – challenge to health and social care sections, recommendations from tribunal. Not known to services not accepted by tribunal
