Can you please provide information about the funds allocated to the Sheffield City Council in connection with the redevelopment of the city centre and specifically the Castlegate area that have come from central government in the past 5 years.

This request has been considered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I am writing to inform you that some of the information you requested is not held by Department for Communities and Local Government. The Department does not hold the information for all of central government.
