****the names of the top 5 shops where the shoplifting incidents have taken place in Wolverhampton (WV1, WV2, WV3, WV4, WV10) in December 2016, 2017 and 2018 - and the number of incidents each year for that month***

****the names of the top 5 shops where the shoplifting incidents have taken place in Birmingham city (B1 B2 B3 B4) in December 2016, 2017 and 2018 - and the number of incidents each year for that month***

**** the total value of the goods taken from each shop***
