Dear all

I wanted to send you a quick note regarding our 'Statement of Community Consultation (SoCC)' for Silvertown, following the comments you made on the draft document.

We've reflected on your comments and have now produced a finalised SoCC. We'll advertise the availability of the SoCC on Monday 21 September via notices in the local press (specifically the titles you suggested), although we'll also email our contacts to let them know the document is available. We'll use this email additionally to promote the roadshow events we've planned.

The SoCC itself will be available on our website www.tfl.gov.uk/silvertown-tunnel, although it won't appear to download until later this week. As the draft version made clear, we'll also make a copy of the SoCC available to inspect in hard copy at four deposit point locations, including Host Borough venues as proposed/agreed. I will have printed and bound two copies of the SoCC for each local authority and will either post it to you directly or have copies ready for our meeting on Thursday afternoon so you can take them away with you.

We've also produced a short paper setting out the feedback we received from each of you on our draft SoCC and an explanation as to how we have responded to this in finalising the document. I've attached this paper along with an electronic copy of the SoCC itself.
