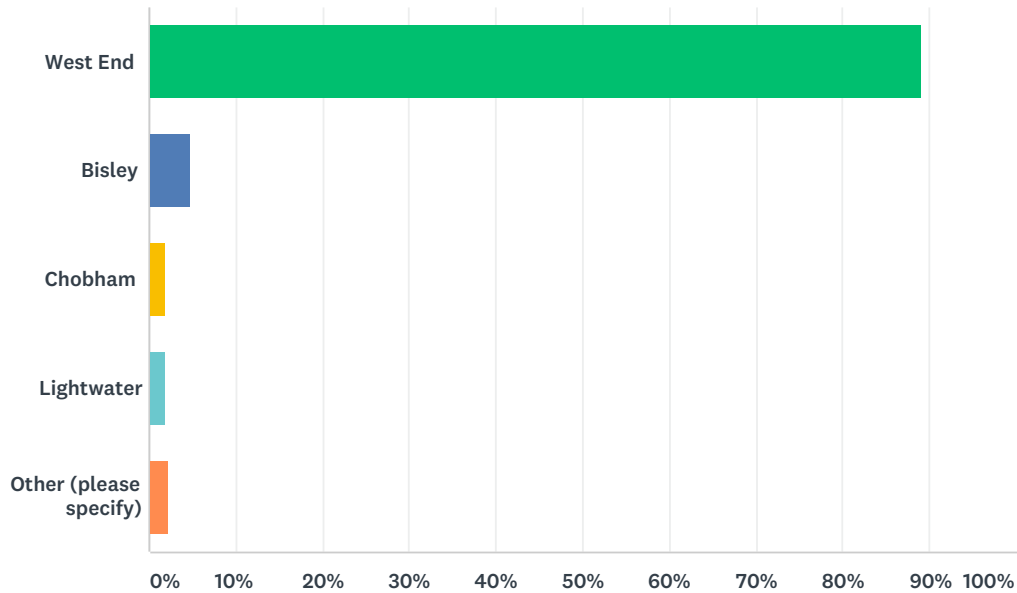

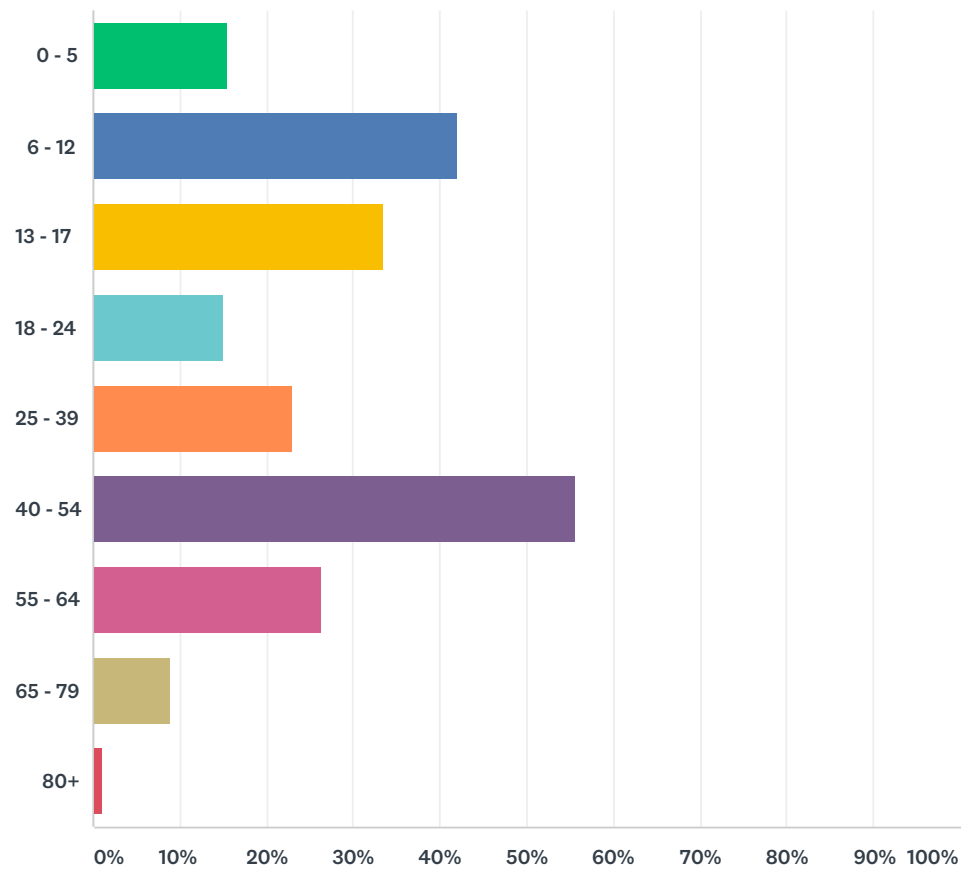

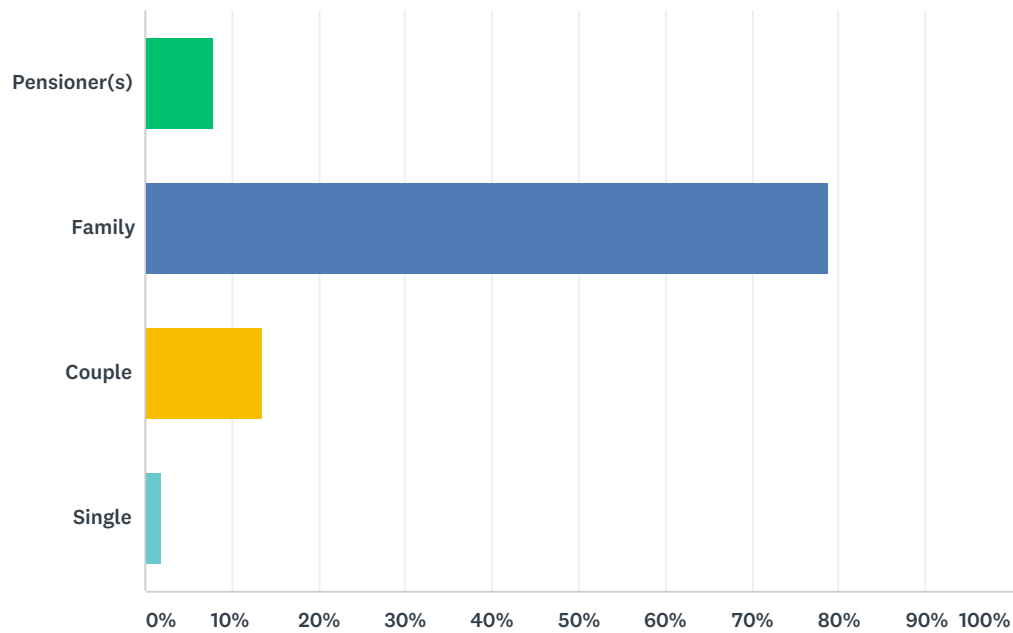

Q6 How would you best describe your household type?

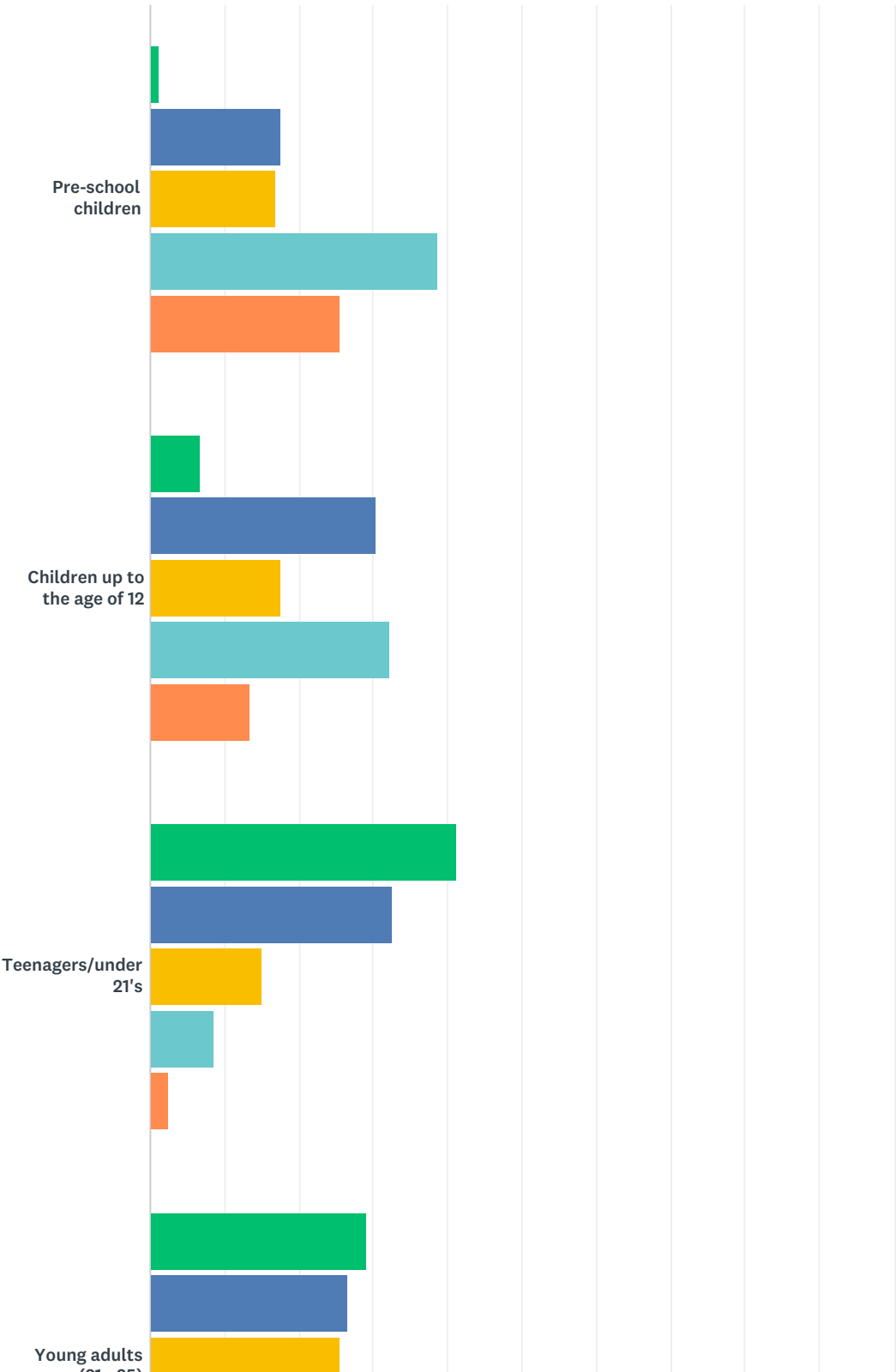

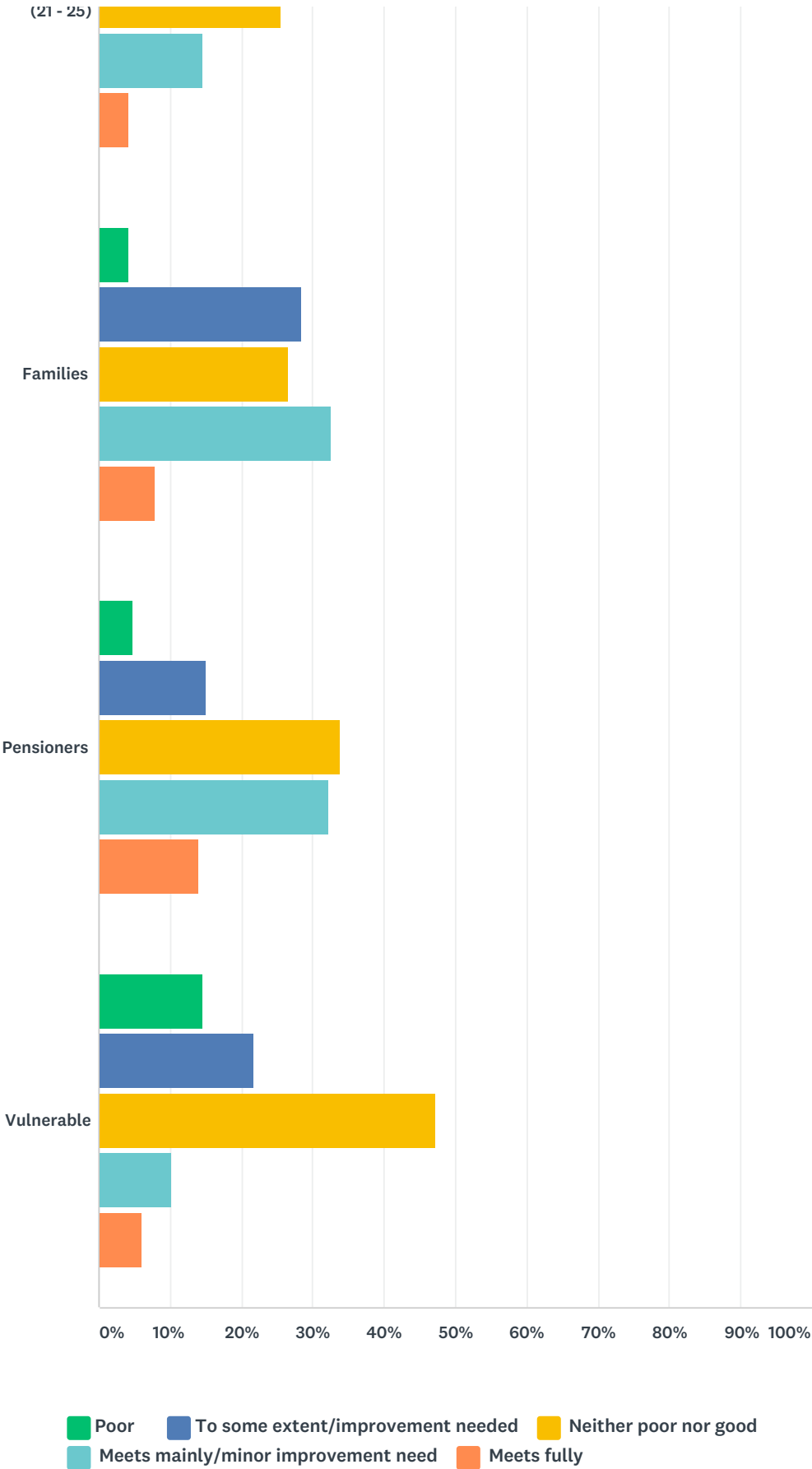

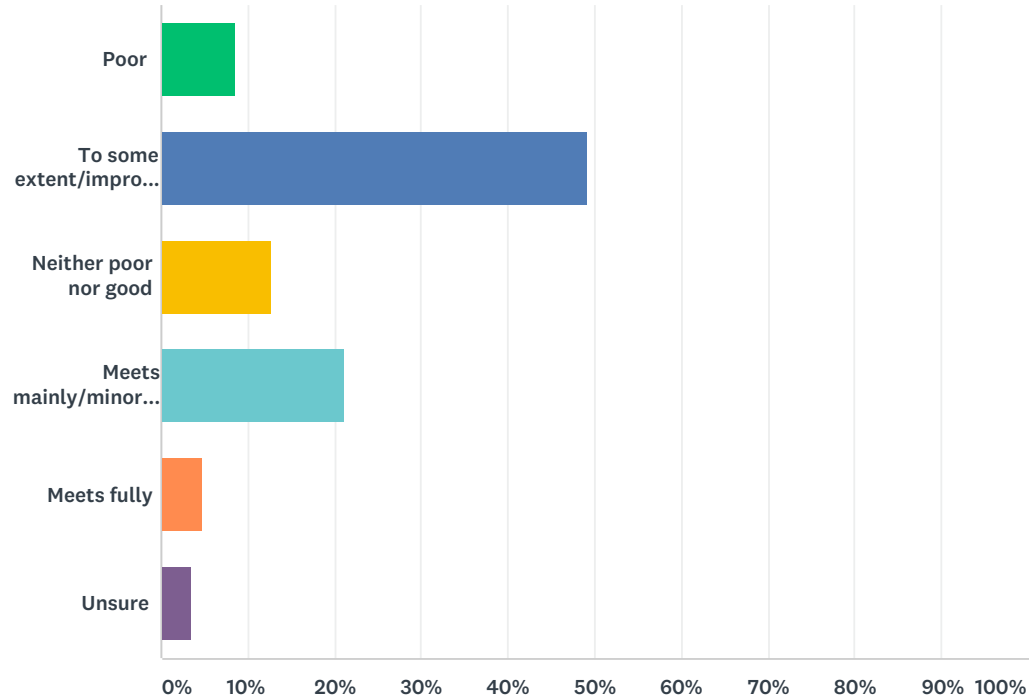

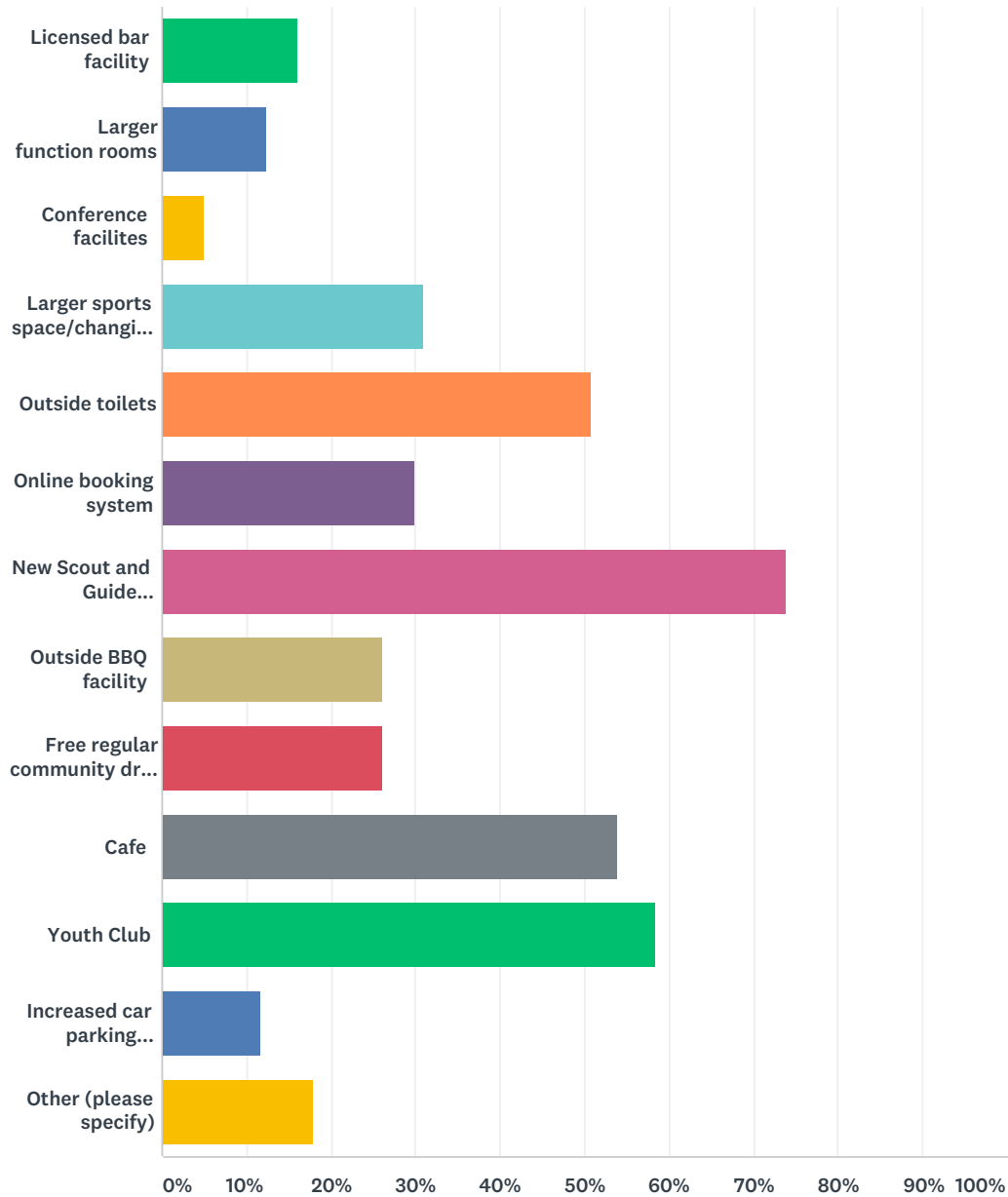

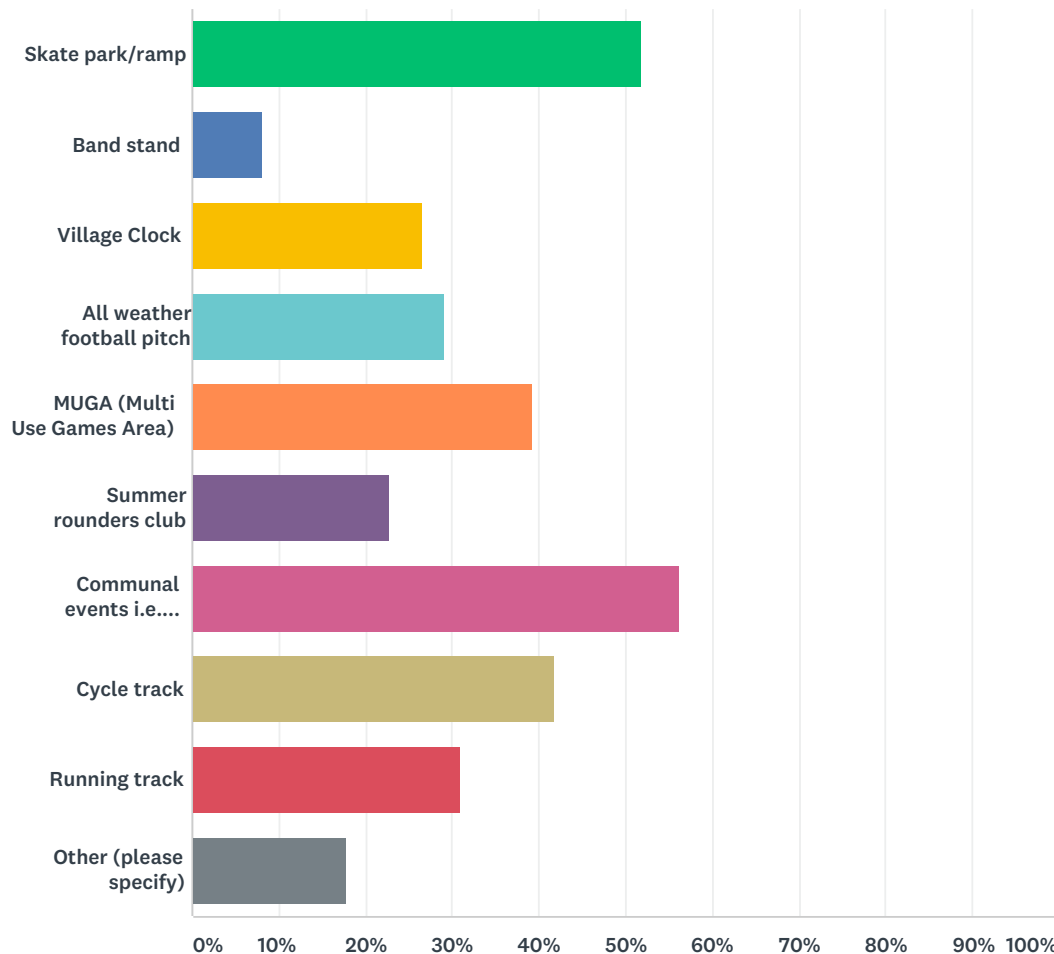
