Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request 2019.140

On the 29th January 2019 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

Thank you very much for a comprehensive reply to my information request. You mention that there are proposals to move to regular rank insignia for the Special Constabulary. Are you able to disclose what these proposals?

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Although these are yet to be confirmed, the proposed insignia for the Special Constabulary is as follows:

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
