I refer to your request where you asked for recorded details of any sanction that may be applied in the event of a breach of standards in public life, with particular reference to Members of Parliament and the Nolan Principles.

I am writing to advise you that this information is not held by the Cabinet Office or Committee on Standards in Public Life.

It may be helpful if we explain that different organisations have their own rules that may apply in the event of a breach of sanctions. In relation to MPs, breaches of standard of conduct should be sent to the Parliamentary Commissioner in the House of Commons.
