**Freedom of Information Act 2000**

Thank you for your request for information that was received on 17 February 2020 concerning the status of the Right of Way from St Luke's Church Road, Formby, from the junction of Bushbys Lane to Alexandra Road and what mode/s of transport are allowed to use the passage.

I can confirm that the information requested is held by Sefton Council. I have detailed below the information that is being released to you.

The Public Right of Way on St Luke's Church Road is a Restricted Byway, which means that motorised forms of transport are prohibited. Any non-motorised form of transport, such as walking, cycling, horse riding or horse drawn carriage, is permitted.

Please quote the reference number 3886017 in any future communications about this request.

Section 17 (7) (a) of the Freedom of Information Act states that public authorities must provide applicants with details of how they may complain about the handling of their request for information should they wish to. If you are not satisfied with the way your request has been dealt with then you can request an internal review within 40 working days of receiving our response.
