### **Freedom of Information Request**

We are writing in response to your Freedom of Information request. Your request has been considered in accordance with the requirements of the Freedom of Information Act and our information access policy.

#### **You asked for the following information:**

“In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, I request the following information:

As of 1st January 2021, or near date, the status of compliance with the Technical Specification for Interoperability - Persons with Reduced Mobility (PRM TSI) for the above classes of train in service with TfW. Please provide the set number(s) and target compliance dates of sets not compliant.

Please also confirm that these sets will always operate coupled with compliant sets.”

#### **Having reviewed your questions, we are able to provide the following information:**

All 36x class 150 units are now fully PRM compliant, this work was completed in 2019.

Of our class 153 units, 13x units were converted to make them compliant by the end of 2019. As at 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2020, 13x remaining class 153 units did not comply PRM accessibility requirements. These units are never operated singly and are always coupled to a fully PRM-compliant class 150 or 153. These units have now been renumbered into the 1539xx number series to ensure they are readily identifiable - a list of these units is given below: -

Work is underway to convert 9x of these units to make them fully PRM compliant in the first half of this year. The other 4x units are to be removed from service.
