ORDER FOLLOWING A COMPLAINT TO STOP UP A HIGHWAY UNDER SECTION 116 AND SCHEDULE 12 OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

<u>BEFORE</u> the Magistrates' Court sitting at The Criminal Justice Centre, Llanberis Road, Caernarfon, Gwynedd LL55 2DF

<u>APPLICATION</u> having been made by Cyngor Sir Ynys Môn / Isle of Anglesey County Council (the Applicant) under section 116 of the Highways Act 1980 that an area of the highway being approximately 85 metres in length and approximately 2.5 metres in width at Holyhead Enterprise Centre, Kingsland Road, Holyhead, Anglesey and shown hatched black on the attached Plan (the Existing Highway) should be stopped up on the ground that it is unnecessary.

<u>AND</u> the Court being satisfied that the Applicant has given the notices required by Part 1 of Schedule 12 to the Highways Act 1980 AND the Court having heard the Application.

AND the Court being satisfied that the said area of highway is unnecessary.


<u>IT IS HEREBY ORDERED</u> that the said area of highway be authorised to be stopped up for the purposes of all public rights.
