STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAY

LENGTH OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH AT WOODLANDS PARK, PICKERING

BEFORE the Magistrates' Court sitting at The Court House, 9 – 27 North Way , Scarborough North Yorkshire YO11 1JH

COMPLAINT having been made by Barry Khan, Head of Assistant Chief Executive, Legal & Democratic Services, County Hall, Northallerton, duly authorised on behalf of North Yorkshire County Council to apply for an Order authorising the County Council to stop up a length of public footpath at Woodlands Park, Pickering in the District of Scarborough, as indicated on the attached plan, on the ground that it is unnecessary.

WHEREFORE the said Barry Khan applied under Section 116 of the Highways Act 1980 for an Order to authorise the said highway to be stopped up.

AND the Court being satisfied that the Complainant has given notice as required by Part I of the 12th Schedule to the Highways Act 1980.


AND the Court being satisfied that the said part of the highway is unnecessary.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the said part of the highway be authorised to be stopped up.
