STEM Summer School Bursary

This bursary was established from the Capita Strategic Technology Partnership and the University's Discretionary Fund allocation which can be used for scholarship/bursaries. The Bursary is intended to provide financial assistance with accommodation and travel costs to students from a Widening Access background who are attending the STEM Summer School.

Eligibility

Registered students of the University's Summer School who have travel and/or accommodation costs which they cannot meet and would deter them from entering or continuing Summer School.

Fall into one of the groups below

- Care Leavers;
- Carers;
- Postcodes in Quintile 1 or 2;
- Attendance at a school with low progression to Higher Education;
- Has an annual household income under £34,000.

Level and Number of Awards

Students within a 25-mile radius of the University can apply for help with travel costs. Awards are likely to be around £50-£200

Students outside of a 25-mile radius can apply for travel or the cost of accommodation to attend Summer School. Awards are likely to be around £150 - £833. Accommodation awards will be capped at the cost of 6 weeks' in University accommodation. (£833).

Application process

Applicants should complete the application form and return to financial-support@strath.ac.uk along with 3 months most recent bank statements.

Care leavers should attach evidence of Care Experience, Carers should enclose any of the evidence listed in the <u>University's Student Carers Policy</u>.

Applications for the bursary will be processed within 2 weeks.
