Dear Mr Pearsall,

Thank you for your Freedom of Information request received on 27 March 2013 in which you ask:

"please can you supply myself with a copy of Guidance issued to DWP staff on disclosure of certain categories of personal medical information to the subject of that information.

I recently received a reply from yourselves stating that DWP do not send copies of medical records to the subject of a SAR. this does not follow the law of the DPA where by law all information must be disclosed (with some legal exemptions).

I am therefore interested in seeing all guidance available in relation to a subject access request, and medical records."

I have enclosed DWP guidance which provides information and advice on how to deal with requests by customers and staff for personal information held about them by DWP. The Subject Access Request Guide (SARG) is for use by Data Protection Officers (DPOs) and their Deputies throughout DWP and aims to provide the basic information they need to handle SARs. The SARG includes guidance on how to:

- gather in medical records see under "Gathering information" "Atos Healthcare Medical Services records"
- how to exempt personal information relating to physical or mental health or condition which, if disclosed, would be likely to cause them **serious** harm – see under "Exemptions" – "The Exemptions" – "Medical data or the health of the customer"

I have also enclosed DWP guidance entitled "Disclosing medical information to the customer".
