Request for Information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your enquiry of 11 June 2010, asking for “compliance data for 2009, 2008 and 2007” for the submarine safety performance metric “Effective Management of Safety”. This is considered to be a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I can confirm that we hold the information you requested for 2008 and 2009. We do not, however, hold information for 2007 as the collection of this data only started in 2008.

The information you requested is in the following table:
