ip&e Ltd paid £16,374.09 plus VAT = **£19,648.91** for occupation of office space at Jupiter House for the period 1st December 2014 to 31st March 2015.

ip&e Ltd paid £10,307.20 for occupation of office space at The Shirehall for the period 1st April 2014 to 30th November 2014.

Recharges for accommodation are performed on a quarterly basis and the charges for Q1 2015/16 have not yet been calculated and invoiced to ip&e Ltd.

3. The number of employees paid by Shropshire Council but working for ip&e. Please confirm any payments received from ip&e in respect of these staff wages.

324 employees are currently on secondment from Shropshire Council to ip&e Ltd.

312 of these employees are seconded as part of services transfers to ip&e Ltd. The cost of these employees is included in the annual contract payment to ip&e Ltd for these services.

The remaining 12 staff are currently undertaking work for ip&e around the establishment of the Company's governance procedures and internal controls. As with the accommodation recharges, the costs incurred in 2015/16 are recharged on a quarterly basis and the Q1 2015/16 have not yet been calculated and invoiced to ip&e. In 2014/15, there were 6 staff that were seconded for a proportion of their time to ip&e Ltd. The total charge for the time spent working directly for ip&e Ltd was £62,578.
