In the clearing periods for UCAS cycles 2017-2020, King’s considered some students with exceptional grades through the Superstar scheme for placement onto courses which were otherwise not available in clearing. Our past criteria for Superstar applicants for all courses have been to meet only the following conditions: at least A*A*A in their top 3 A-Levels, or equivalent IB grades. Meeting this criterion did not, however, guarantee an offer.
