Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act)

The council has considered your request which was received on 12 October 2020 and our response to your questions is shown below.

 I would like to know how much each school in the LA spent on temporary supply teaching and other supply staff from external supply teaching agencies from September 1st 2020 - 12th October 2020. I would like to know this information for each Nursery, Primary, Secondary and SEND school.

In accordance with section 1(1) of the Act the council has a duty to confirm whether it holds the information of the description specified in the request, and if that is the case, to have the information communicated to the requester.

The council is only able to provide this information for maintained schools and does not have any maintained secondary schools. Under section 1 of the Act this information cannot be provided, as it is not held by the council.
