Thank you for your request for information.

Your Request & Our Response

I should like to request the following information about the emotional support and crisis services available to people under the age of 18 in Blackpool, which falls within the geographical remit of your organisation.

I would like to find out the following information about the services that you are commissioned to deliver in Blackpool to people under the age of 18 who are experiencing emotional distress and/or who are at risk of attempting suicide:

- Inclusion/exclusion criteria
- How the service is accessed, i.e. open access, self-referral, third party referral

All referrals go through single point of access from any professional working with a young person, self referral is also accepted, again this will come through SPOA.

Channels of support, e.g. telephone, email, text, webchat, face-to-face, and types
of location if face-to-face

Service user's preferences in terms of face to face/zoom, phone contact is considered where appropriate and service users are at the centre of care planning, this is audited monthly to ensure the young person's voice is included in the planning.

Opening hours/availability

All mental health services routinely work Monday to Friday 9-5 CASHER work 5pm till 9.00am the next morning and all day and nights over the weekend.

 Type of support provided, i.e., structured therapeutic counselling, peer support, helpline

There are a range of therapeutic offers from all services which include: Dialectical Behaviour Therapy, Cognitive Behaviour Therapy & eye movement desensitization and reprocessing alongside risk management and support through crisis intervention and psycho-social interventions. All therapeutic interventions follow NICE guidance (national institute for clinical excellence) in terms of evidence based time frames, however, with the caveat that some require furthermore intensive support.

If support is provided to parents or carers

Children and young people serives support families to manage risks and keeping safe care plans, all service users preferences in terms of face to face/zoom, phone contact is considered where appropriate and service users are at the centre of care planning, this is audited monthly to ensure the young person's voice is included in the planning.

Length of support offered

Varied dependent on each separate case

If the support is provided by paid employees, freelance/contract staff, volunteers.

The team members are all employed by Blackpool Teaching Hospitals, however, we have close links with Voluntary, community, faith and social enterprise sectors and adult menal Health and learning disabilities services are integrated with Local Authority (Health managed by Blackpool Teaching Hospitals) (Thrive aligned).

• Intended outcomes for the service

Future planning around Children and young people is to have the ADHD pathway sit separately from the single point of access and create a team for this particular presentation due to referrals for this going up significantly year on year. Plans to streamline our EPR systems so all Mental Health and Learning Disability services are using the same one and able to capture data more accurately. Increase nurse led clinics and senior nursing roles.

• Where relevant, number of people under 18 that have been referred to the service in the most recent reporting period (quarter or year)

2058 unique patients aged Under 18 were referred to Children and young people Mental Health services (CAMHS, CASHER, Youtherapy, Mental Health Schools teams) in 2021/22.

Please note this is the unique number of people the number of referrals is far higher due to multiple referrals.

 Number of people under 18 supported in the most recent reporting period (quarter or year)

2817 unique patients aged under 18 had activity with Children and young people Mental Health services (CAMHS, CASHER, Youtherapy, Mental Health Schools teams) in 2021/22.

Please note that this is the number of patients rather than the number of contact as requested in the FOI.
