Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Learning Disability Supported Living

I am writing to confirm that the South Eastern Health & Social Care Trust (the Trust) has now completed its search for the information relating to the above which you requested on 23 October 2014.

In response to the request for information, Adult Disability Services can report the following:

Q1. When did learning disability supported living commence in Lisburn?

A1. Trust supported living service for adults with a learning disability commenced in December 2008. The Trust would not hold information regarding Independent Sector Supported Living Schemes.

Q2. How many houses in Lisburn Currently have learning disability service users being supported in them?

A2. There are a total of 34 houses, 17 single tenancy and 17 shared tenancy.

Under the terms of the legislation, if you are unhappy with this response you have the right to seek a review within the Trust in the first instance. If you wish to do so, please write to me at the address below.

If after such a review you are still unhappy with the response, you have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner who will undertake an independent review.
