Dear Mr Proctor

We have now had the opportunity to carry out an internal review of your Freedom of Information request above.

In your email of 10th August, you stated the following:

"Firstly, I requested information regarding the reason for their suspension. As per the Freedom of information act 2000, you have a duty to undertake a public interest test. You failed to do so. My request was worded, such that if my original request failed the public interest test, whether further information regarding external bodies could be ascertained. If you refused my first request, you would have to undertake a second public interest test on the second, less detailed request. In my opinion, it's difficult to interpret my request as not requiring a response beyond 'we won't divulge information without any reasoning."

It is considered that the Council's initial response provided you with the information you requested, including the reason for suspension, i.e. due to 'concerns over officer conduct'. Given that no information was withheld, no public interest test was required. In your final paragraph you stated: "If you cannot go into details, please could you outline, which if any, of the following agencies, are involved in the internal investigations, and if possible, to which suspended staff they concern......"

We did not respond to your final paragraph as we did provide the detail you requested.
