The details we require are:

2. Actual spend on this contract/framework (and any sub lots), from the start of the contract to the current date.	Information not held as the Framework has not yet commenced.
3. Start date & duration of framework.	Information not held for start date as yet to be confirmed. The initial Framework term will be for 12 months.
