You asked:

"Please can you give me any information, in electronic form, regarding the General Board's and University Council's activities regarding the Teaching and Learning review including draft documents. I am specifically interested in any activity since the ISG's paper to the General Board (10.C.21)."

Paper 10.C.21 was discussed at the General Board's meeting on 28 April 2010. The Board, at its meeting on 2 June 2010, received a Report on the incorporation of the Centre for Applied Research in Education Technologies (CARET) into the University Library (Paper No. 10.A.14). The Council received the minutes of the General Board's meeting on 2 June 2010 in Council circular 15/10 which was distributed on 7 May 2010.
