Dear Sir/Madam,

Thank you for your request for information, received by West Yorkshire Police on 18/05/2023.

You requested the following information:

Please provide the details of the temporary speed camera (variable or average speed) used on Motorway M62 Westbound between Junction 29 and 28 on Saturday 13/05/2023, the max speed limit it was set to and the calibration status of the camera.

Also please provide the speed limit set on the motorway M62 Westbound between Junctions 29 and 28 on Saturday 13/05/2023.

On Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> May, the cameras used on the M62 Westbound between junction 29 – 28 are Yunex Average speed cameras. They are currently fully calibrated to detect speeding vehicles, and the temporary speed set on this part of the motorway (through the roadworks) is currently set at 50 mph.

If the above speed limit is less than the National Speed limit, please provide the number and location of the speed limit signs from the point where it changes from National Speed Limit to the speed camera between Junctions 29 and 28 westbound on M62.

West Yorkshire Police do not hold this information. This information would have to be requested from National Highways or the contractors who have erected the signage.

## COMPLAINT RIGHTS

If you are dissatisfied with the handling procedures or the decision of West Yorkshire Police, made under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 regarding access to information, you can lodge a written complaint to have the decision internally reviewed.

A West Yorkshire Police internal review of your decision will be carried out by an alternative member of staff who is fully trained in interpreting Freedom of Information legislation. The review will be independently conducted, regardless of the original decision made.

Complaints will only be treated as valid if they are received by West Yorkshire Police within a 60-day timeframe from the date of the decision letter. They must include the original FOI Reference Number and can only be submitted in writing, by using the following contact details:
