PAY REVIEW 1987 - REVISED PAY RATES, ALLOWANCES AND CHARGES FOR THE REGULAR ARMY, TA AND UDR.

#### References :

A. D/AG Sec 2/48/30/1 dated 30 June 1986

1. I am directed to inform you of changes in rates of pay, additional pay, allowances and charges following Government consideration of the Armed Forces Pay Review Body's Sixteenth Report 1987, published as Command Paper 126. The revised rates, which supersede those notified in Reference A, are set out in the annexes attached to this letter. They are effective from 1 April 1987

#### PAY

Medical and Dental Officers

Revised rates of pay for medical and dental officers in the rank of Brigadier and below will be published in a separate letter.

#### Senior Officers

3. Revised rates of pay for combatant and medical and dental officers in the rank of Major General and above (excluding the Chaplain General) will be published in a separate letter.

#### Drigade of Gurkhas

4. Revised rates of UK addition effective from 1 April 1987 for officers and soldiers of the Brigade of Gurkhas will be published separately.

#### Army Cadet Force and Combined Cadet Forces

5. Revised rates of pay effective from 1 April 1987 for officers and soldiers of the Army Cadet Force and the Combined Cadet Force will be published separately.

Territorial Army - Pay for Drill Nights

6. With effect from 1 April 1987 there is a change in the regulations for drill night payments. Details will be promulgated in a separate letter.

7. The personnel referred to in paragraph 2 are to continue to pay food and accommodation charges at the existing rates until their new pay rates are promulgated. The letter promulgating their revised rates of pay will incorporate advice on the implementation of revised charges.

Accommodation Charges - Staging

8. The four tier grading system introduced on 1 April 1985 resulted in some sub-standard accommodation being classified as Grade 3 or Grade 2. To reduce the effect of the increase on those servicemen whose accommodation fell into these categories, staging arrangements were agreed. These were completed by 31 Staging arrangements were agreed. These were completed by 31 March 1987 and the appropriate charge as shown at Annex H(1)-H(3) will apply.

OTHER CHARGES

Refund of Life Assurance Premium Loadings for Service Risks

9. The maximum "total sum assured" in respect of which partial refund of premiums may be called has been raised to £58,000 with effect from 1 April 1987.

Training Bounties

10. There is no change to the level of training bounties.

Recruits - Discharge by Purchase

11. With effect from 1 June 1987 the charge payable by male and female recruits aged 17% years and over who claim their discharge as a statutory right under the terms of paragraph 9.293 of the Queen's Regulations for the Army 1975 has been increased from £95 to £100.

### GENERAL

- 12. A key to the annexes is attached. In the case where a rate, allowance or charge does not appear in the annexes and its absence is not explained in this letter, you are to assume that there has been no change and that the existing level will continue to apply.
- 13. The Pay Warrant 1964, the Regulations for Army Allowances and Charges, the Regulations for the Territorial Army 1978 and the Regulations for the Ulster Defence Regiment 1980 will be amended as soon as possible.
