PAY REVIEW 1990 - REVISED PAY RATES, ALLOWANCES AND CHARGES FOR THE REGULAR ARMY, TA AND UDR

Reference:

A. D/AG Sec 2/48/32/11 dated 20 March 1989.

I am directed to inform you of changes in rates of pay, additional pay, allowances and charges following Government consideration of the Armed Forces Pay Review Body's nineteenth Report 1990, published as Command 936. The revised rates, which supersede those notified in Reference A, are set out in the annexes attached to this letter. The Government has also decided to implement the recommendations contained in the Top Salaries Review Body's Report No 29, published as Command 938. The revised rates of pay are effective in two stages. Stage 1 increases are effective from 1 April 1990 and Stage 2 from 1 January 1991.

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X FACTOR

2. The X Factor enhancement to rates of pay for Regular Officers and Soldiers is increased from 1 April 1990 to 10.5% for men and 9.5% for women. The X Factor for members of the Reserve forces is unchanged at 5% for Servicemen and 4.5% for Servicewomen.

Medical and Dental Officers

3. Revised rates of pay for medical and dental officers in the rank of Brigadier and below will be published in a separate letter.

Senior Officers The Polyton Senior Stand Stand of Senior Officers

Revised rates of pay for combatant and medical and dental officers in the rank of Major General and above (excluding the Chaplain General) are set out at Annex A8.

Brigade of Gurkhas

5. Revised rates of UK addition effective from 1 April 1990 and 1 January 1991 for officers and soldiers of the Brigade of Curkhas will be published separately.

Army Cadet Force and Combined Cadet Forces

 Revised rates of pay effective from 1 April 1990 and 1 January 1991 for officers and soldiers of the Army Cadet Force and the Combined Cadet Force will be published separately.

RETENTION INCENTIVE BONUSES

SOLDIERS

7. With effect from 1 January 1991 new terms of Service, the Open Engagement, will be introduced for new entrants soldiers. Scale B and C rates of committal pay will be replaced by a bonus to be paid at the point at which a soldier is committed to 6 or 9 years service. There are special arrangements for those already serving.

New Entrants. Those joining from 1 January 1991 will do so on new terms of engagement. The current engagement options of less than 6 years, more than 6 but less than 9 years and 9 years or more and the associated entitlement to Scale A, B or C rates of pay will no longer be available. Instead engagement length will not be fixed; a soldier may give 12 months' notice to terminate his employment at any time after completing 2 years' reckonable service. A bonus of £2000 gross will be payable to soldiers after completion 5 and 8 years service when they will be committed to serving 6 and 9 years respectively (taking into account the standard 12 month notice required for termination of serivce). Rates of pay for all personnel will be Scale A until completion of 9 years service when Scale C rates will become effective.

Personnel already serving. For those already serving and completing 5 or 8 years' service on or after 1 January 1991 bonuses of £2000 gross will be paid at the 5 and 8 year points. Payment will be subject to a commitment to serve for a further 12 months to complete 6 or 9 years as appropriate. These personnel will continue to receive committal pay on Scale B or C rates if they qualify under the present rules.

OFFICERS

With effect from 1 January 1991, officers serving on Regular Commissions and paid on the main salary scales for male and female officers will be eligible for a bonus of £6500 gross on completion of 6 years reckonable service or on promotion to substantive Captain, whichever is the later and a further bonus of £6500 gross on completion of 9 years reckonable service or on promotion to substantive Major, whichever is the later. Those receiving bonuses will be required to complete at least 3 years further service from the date of payment.

Serving Captains aged under 32 with more than 6 but less than 8 years reckonable service on 1 January 1991 will be eligible for the first award.

These bonuses do not apply to officers paid on medical and dental, veterinary officer and chaplain scales.

ADDITIONAL PAY

FLYING PAY

8. New Rates of Flying pay have been introduced for Aircraft Commanders who are Lt Col with more than 6 years in the rank and above. The relationship with the Middle rate has been discarded and replaced by new rates with additional, decreasing, steps in order to preserve adequate differentials on promotion.

Flying Training Pay is abolished for those entering training on or after 1 April 1990. Trainees currently receiving Flying Training Pay will retain it in accordance with the regulations under which they qualified.

CHARGES

9. The Rates charge for accommodation in England and Wales will cease from l April 1990 on introduction of the Personal Community Charge. A separate Water Charge will be included in the accommodation charge paid by personnel in England and Wales and those in Scotland who are not liable for a personal Water Charge. A local scale of Accommodation Charges has been introduced for Northern Ireland. A facilities charge will replace the Accommodation Rates element for all those serving overseas with a liability for accommodation charges.

OTHER CHANGES

Refund of Life Assurance Premium Loadings for Service Risks

10. The maximum "total sum assured" in respect of which partial refund of premiums may be claimed has been raised to £74,000 with effect from 1 April 1990 and £80,000 with effect from 1 January 1991.

Recruits - Discharge by Purchase

ll. The charge payable by male and female recruits aged $17\frac{1}{2}$ years and over who claim their discharge as a statutory right under the terms of paragraph 9.293 of the Queens Regulations for the Army 1975 has been increased to £120.

GENERAL

- 12. A key to the annexes is attached. In the case where a rate, allowance or charge does not appear in the annexes and its absence is not explained in this letter, you are to assume that there has been no change and that the existing level will continue to apply.
- 13. The Pay Warrant 1964, the Regulations for Army Allowances and Charges, the Regulations for the Territorial Army 1978 and the Regulations for the Ulster Defence Regiment 1980 will be amended as soon as possible.
