14. The new rates of training bounty shown in Annex E(3) are to be paid to part-time members of the UDR for training years commencing on or after 1 April 1982. The normal qualifying conditions will apply. As bounties are paid at the end of training years, the first payments at the new rates will normally be made on or after 1 April 1983. However, any UDR member who begins a new training year on or after 1 April 1982, and subsequently becomes eligible for a proportional bounty before 1 April 1983 in the circumstances described in the Directed Letters D/F2(AD)/69/20/1B dated 24 Mar 81 and 5 Oct 81 is to receive the appropriate proportional bounty at the new rate.

GENERAL

15. A key to the annexes is attached below. In the case where a rate, allowance or charge does not appear and its absence is not explained in the body of this letter, you are to assume that there is no change and that the existing level will continue to apply.

16. I am to say that the Pay Warrant 1964, the Regulations for Army Allowances and Charges, the Regulations for the Territorial Army and Volunteer Reserve 1978 and the Regulations for the Ulster Defence Regiment 1980 will be amended in due course.
