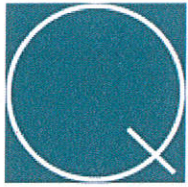
I am sure we will be able to organise visits to sites as and when is required.

We have worked on a number of similar projects in the past and having reviewed the information and scope of work, we would propose the following fees;

- Attendance at meetings

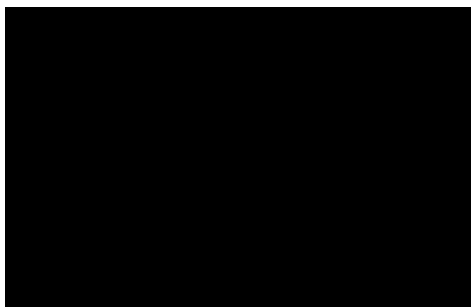
We would propose a separate fee of **£1,100.00 + VAT** for the production of 3no 3d images, including . amendments post consultation.

Victory Park Pavilion

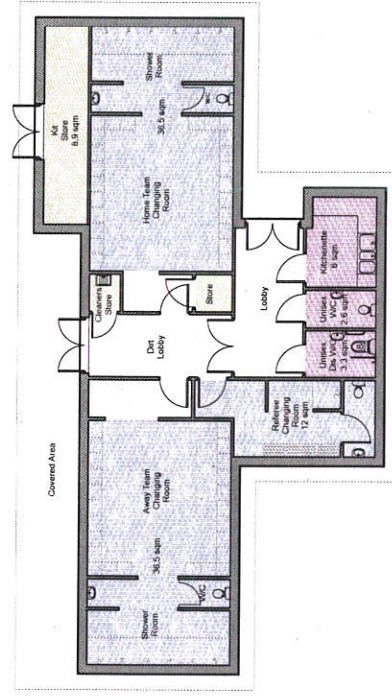
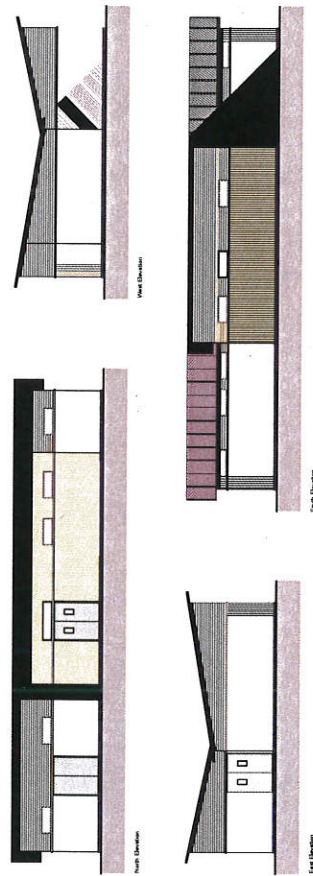
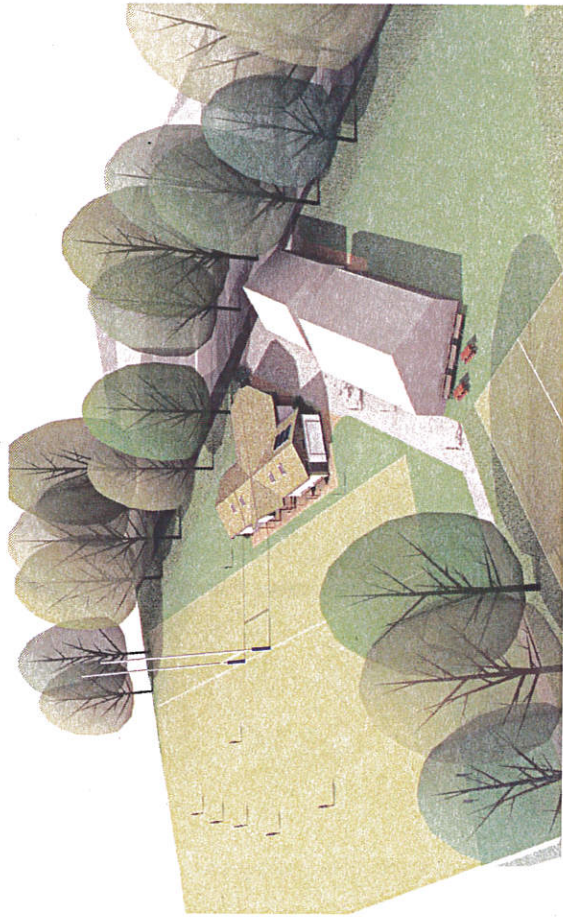

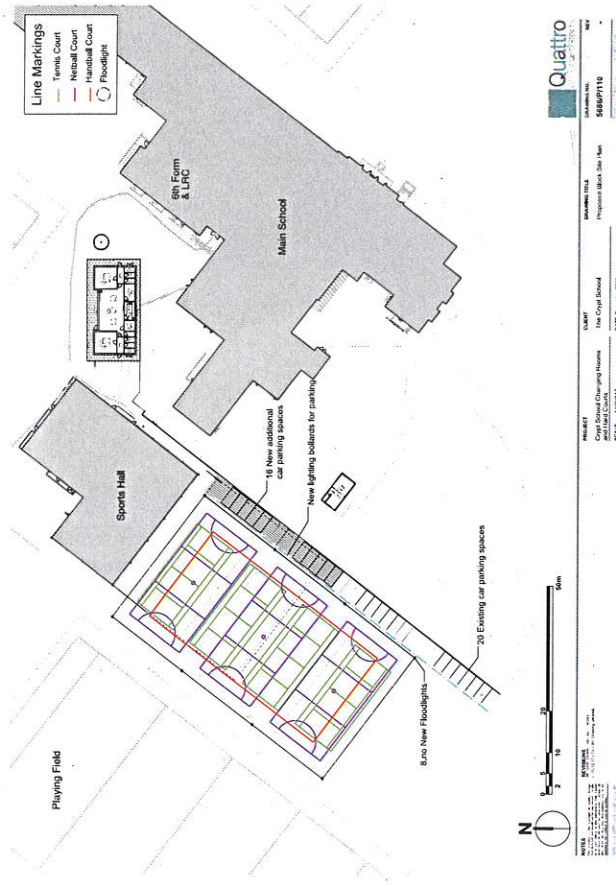
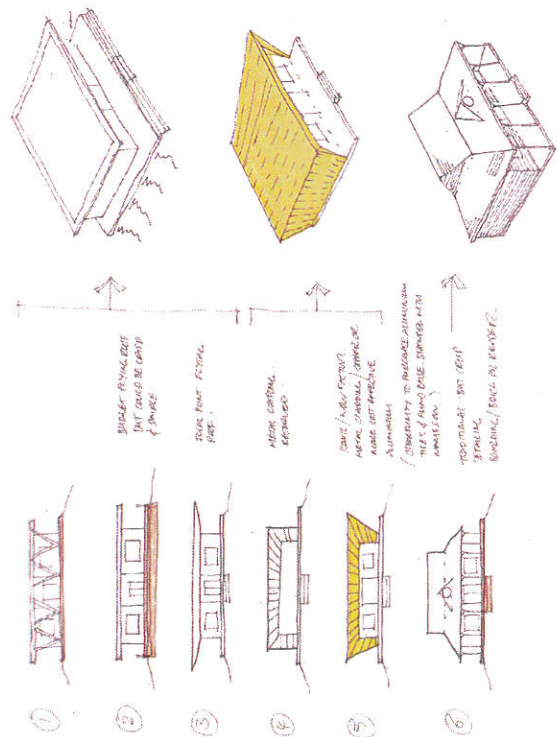
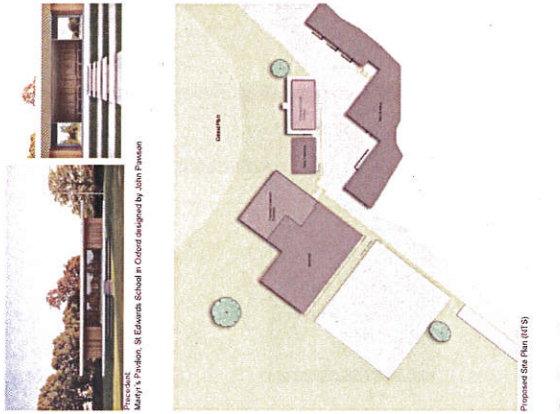
Crypt Cricket Pavilion

Project Background:

This striking proposal has been prepared for Crypt School in order to update their current out-of-date facilities. The approximately 70m² pavilion is made up of changing facilities including showers, WCs, kitchenette and communal dining/multi-use space.

We've worked closely with the client and the principle stakeholders to achieve Sport England compliant facilities that meet the requirement of the brief and work within the budget available. The client intends to tender the project June/July 2018 with a view to start works toward the end of the summer.

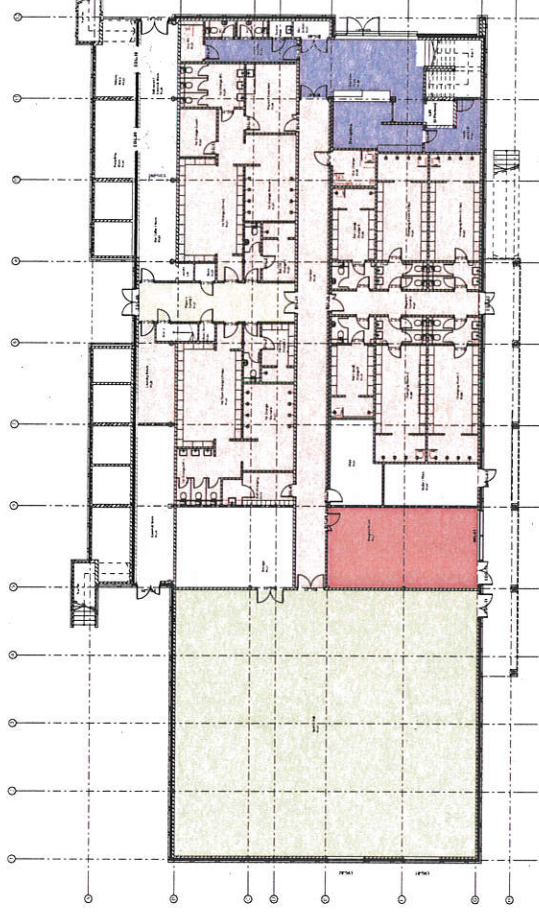

Project Background:

Quattro were successfully selected, alongside Beard Construction, to develop a new rugby ground for Dings Crusaders RFC - one of Bristol's oldest rugby clubs.

The proposal was for a covered stand that could accommodate 200 spectators, a new clubhouse featuring a club room, two-court sports hall, weight training room, changing rooms, and a club shop; alongside a full-size all-weather floodlit pitch, full-size grass pitch, floodlit training pitch and three junior pitches.

The ground also provided new opportunities for the club to use the facilities on non-match days. Hosting conferences, exhibitions and events provided alternative and valuable commercial opportunities, alongside the traditional hospitality and match day experiences.
