I refer to your request where you asked:

'I am a student journalist from Northern Ireland and am feeling anxious about the vote on the Withdrawal Agreement tonight. I highly hope that the deal gets through, but if it is defeated, will Mrs May consider putting the Withdrawal Agreement to the Public as a People's Vote?'

This question does not constitute a valid request for information as outlined in the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Act gives a right of access to recorded information that already exists. It does not require public authorities to create new information in order to respond to a request.
