(VARIABLE 20mph SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2004

South Ayrshire Council, ("the Council"), in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "South Ayrshire Council (Barrhill Primary School, Barrhill) (Variable 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2004", and shall come into operation on the 24th day of January 2005.
2. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
3. The interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.
4. In this Order the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them:

“**vehicle**” means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power;

5. (1) No person shall drive a vehicle on the length of road specified in the schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding-

- (a) 20 miles per hour, whilst such a speed is indicated by a traffic sign in accordance with paragraph (2) below; or
 - (b) 30 miles per hour, at any other time.
- (2) Such an indication may be given at any time between the hours of 8.00am and 4.30pm on Mondays to Fridays.

This Order together with the Schedule annexed and signed as relative hereto are subscribed for and behalf of South Ayrshire Council by Daniel Chapman Russell (subscribing his usual signature “Dan Russell”), Head of Legal and Administration and one of the Council`s officers authorised to sign deeds, at Ayr on the Third day of December, Two thousand and four before this witness [REDACTED], Principal Solicitor with South Ayrshire Council at County Buildings, Wellington Square, Ayr.

Lengths of Road within South Ayrshire

1. That length of the A714 (Girvan to Newton Stewart Road), from a point 10 metres northwest of the extended northwest kerbline of the C72 (Barrhill to Chirmorrie Road), northwestwards for a distance of 220 metres or thereby.
