South Ayrshire Council, ("the Council"), in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 1, 81 to 85, as amended, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as "South Ayrshire Council (Various Streets, Barr) (Speed Limit Amendment and Consolidation) Order 2012", and shall come into operation on the 9<sup>th</sup> November 2012.
- 2. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
- 3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.
- 4. In this Order the following expression shall have a meaning hereby assigned to it:
  - "vehicle" means a vehicle of any description and including a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along a road whether or not by mechanical power;
- 5. That the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules annexed and executed as relative to this Order shall become restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81 (1) and (2) of the Act, which reduces the speed limit on a restricted road.
- 6. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20mph on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule 1 annexed and executed as relative to this Order, and shown coloured green on the plan annexed hereto.

- 7. That the area currently designated a 30 mph zone shown coloured red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto shall increase in size to also include the area of road referred to in Schedule 3 annexed and executed as relative to this Order.
- 8. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule 2 and 3 to this Order.
