The Tower Hamlets (C3 Parking Places) (No.1) Experimental Order 2010

Made: 26 February 2010

Coming into operation: 5 March 2010

The Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985 (b) and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (c) and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order: -

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Tower Hamlets (C3 Parking Places) (No.1) Experimental Order 2010 and shall come into operation on 5 March 2010.
2.
 - (i) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment;
 - (ii) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2008 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Designation of Parking Places and application of the Order of 2005 thereto

3. (i) Each area of a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of a Schedule to this Order and unless otherwise so specified, bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a minimum width throughout of 1.8 metres is designated as a Parking Place.
- (ii) The provisions of the Order of 2005 (other than Articles 3 and 26) shall apply to the areas designated as Parking Places by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a Parking Place included a reference to an area designated as a Parking Place by this Order and as if any reference to a Schedule to the Order of 2005 included a reference to a Schedule to this Order.

Placing of Traffic Signs etc.

4. The Council shall place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each Parking Place.
5. In pursuance of Section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Service Head, Environmental Control Services of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets for the time being (or some other person authorised in that behalf by him) may, if it appears to him or that person essential in the interest of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs, modify or suspend this Order or any provision thereof.

SCHEDULE 30

In relation to a parking place referred to in this schedule, the expression “permitted hours” unless otherwise specified, means the period At Any Time on Mondays to Sundays inclusive (any such day not being a Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday)

Parking Places in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours free of any parking charge for which a vehicle may wait for a maximum period of 10 minutes, with no return being allowed within 40 minutes.
