FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 – INFORMATION REQUEST

Thank you for your e-mail of 29th April 2016 in which you requested information regarding the mis-fuelling of vehicles owned and/or leased by the London Borough of Enfield.

The Council vehicle fleet is predominately diesel powered and the council provides fuel for these vehicles via its diesel bulk fuel installation on site at the Morson Road and Pymmes Park Depots.

The only road vehicle with a petrol engine is the mayor's car which is issued with a fuel card.

During the period requested we have no record of any leased or asset vehicles suffering mis-fuelling and thus have not incurred any costs for this repair.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to:
